WELLINGTON AFC Club History

Formed in 1892, we are proud to be an FA Accredited Club. Initially, the club played in leagues based around Taunton and Tiverton. In the early 1960s, we gained promotion to the Somerset Senior League and succeeded in achieving Western League status in 1978 which has been retained ever since, making us one of the league's longest continuously-serving members.

The First Team entered the Western League in the First Division in the 1978-79 season and played at Premier Division level from 1981-82 to 1984-85 and 2008-09 to 2010-11. The team were then promoted as First Division Champions at the end of the 2016-17 season. In their first season back in the Premier Division, the team finished a creditable 15th and also reached the semi-final of the Somerset Premier Cup losing 4-1 away to Southern League club Paulton Rovers. The following season, the team finished in 16th place but unfortunately, the next two campaigns were brought to an early conclusion by the Coronavirus pandemic.

Last season provided new challenges for the team, including starting the season with a trip to Mousehole and a final match at Helston on Easter Monday. The side achieved their highest position in the Toolstation Premier League since the 2009-10 season (14th) and equaled the club's longest run in the FA Vase (third round). The 2022-23 season again presents new challenges and new grounds to visit with teams being promoted to and relegated into the Premier Division. Joint managers Tim Legg and Alex Pope are again in charge of the side.

The Reserves were top of Division One West in the Devon and Exeter League when the 2020-21 season was terminated due to the Covid pandemic. The league took the opportunity to restructure for the start of the 2021-22 season and move away from the East and West Divisions and, as a result, the Reserves were placed in Division One where they finished in fifth place. Although there has been some movement of teams within the league the Reserves, under new manager, Nick Buttle, have remained in Division One for this season.

Having played in the Devon and Exeter League for a number of seasons, the A team transferred to Division Three of the Taunton Saturday League for the 2018-19 season when they finished a creditable third, gaining promotion to

Division Two for the 2019-20 season. They gained further promotion to Division One for the 2020-21 season and were topping the table when the season was forced to end due to the Covid pandemic. They won their group in the league's Covid Cup and also won the Seward Cup held over from 2019-20. Last season they finished in fifth place and, under manager Warren Toth, are in Division One again this for this campaign.

The club's Ladies played in the Somerset County Women's League Division Two (Flexi) in the 2020-21 season, finishing a creditable third when the season resumed. Last season they again played in Division Two where they finished in second place and reached the quarter-finals of the League Knock-Out Cup. Under manager Nyima Touray, they have been promoted to Division One for the 2022-23 campaign. This season there is also an additional Ladies Development Team, giving the opportunity for players to progress from the Wildcats Under 16s to senior football.

Last season, our youth teams once again performed well in their respective league and cup competitions, notably the Under 14s Town won their division and were runners-up in the league cup while the Under 12s United and Under 15s Town teams both finished runners-up in their division. All the other youth teams, boys and an increasing number of girls, acquitted themselves well and continue to be run by a small army of enthusiastic volunteers.

Our three Disability teams also performed well in their league and, this season, instead of three adult teams, we have two adult teams and a youth team.

In total this season, the club are running no fewer than 33 teams.

We continue to work with the town and district councils to pursue the club's attempts to establish a new First Team facility on land on the new Longforth Farm Estate on the edge of the town. This would then free-up the Playing Field for other teams to use. We are also working with the Wellington Sports Federation on the Somerset West and Taunton Playing Pitch Strategy regarding other land in the town where it is proposed a number of youth sports pitches would be provided.

Outside our core footballing activities, Wellington AFC is home to several darts and skittles teams and we run a full programme of social events for members and non-members alike with the impressive Function Room and Lounge available for hire.

MATCH REPORT

WELLINGTON 1 0 BARNSTAPLE TOWN

Wellington AFC ripped up the form book with an excellent victory over fifth-placed Barnstaple Town at the Playing Field on Wednesday evening (15th February).

The Tangerines went into the game on the back of two 4-0 defeats while the visitors had racked up six successive league victories. But Wellington gave a gritty display to earn three valuable points as they climb away from the lower reaches of the table.

The hosts included fit-again centre defender Tom Stone and, with keeper Harley Wilkinson unavailable, there was a return between the posts for teenager Shay Allen.

Wellington got off to a bright start and Jack Bown-Porter had a shot blocked in the second minute while Alfie Clark saw a lob ruled out for offside and Jake Quick also went close on a couple of occasions in the first half.

It was an entertaining contest with Barnstaple also creating chances, the best of them falling to Tor Swann after 40 minutes. He seemed certain to convert Stuart Bowker's pass from close range but Allen produced a fine reaction save.

The breakthrough finally came five minutes into the second half as Wellington were handed a slice of luck to score what proved to be the winner. Defender Stefan Phillips lobbed the ball into the area from the right and visiting defender David Slade turned it past his own keeper and just inside the post.

Wellington nearly went 2-0 up after 72 minutes as Ryan Brereton's shot was pushed on to the bar by keeper Liam Kingston and Miles Quick converted the rebound but the flag was up for offside.

Despite having a player sin binned for ten minutes, Barnstaple launched attack after attack on the home goal but Wellington defended heroically and prevented any clear-cut chances being created by the increasingly frustrated visitors.

It was the first of three successive home games for the Tangerines and they will be looking to build on the result this afternoon.



TODAY'S VISITORS CADBURY HEATH

We extend a warm welcome to the players, officials and supporters of Cadbury Heath for today's Toolstation League Premier Division game.

The Club was first established in 1894 by Cadbury Heath Adult School (later to be known as Cadbury Heath Primary School) when Cadbury Heath was just a little narrow, one-street village, way outside the boundaries of Bristol. Our first pitch was situated at Mill Lane, changing in the Social Club and heating up water for tin baths.

With a break for the War years, and the transferring to what is now Coronation Park, we progressed from the Bristol & District League to Division Two of the Bristol Premier Combination, and then to Division One in 1961, after winning the GFA Junior Cup in 1950. In the 60's the team built their own baths at the Social Club. This period of success coincided with the renting of our present Springfield Ground for £10 per annum from our President Jim Warner. This was then an open pasture land with cows, a rope had to be put around the playing area. It had no electricity water or drainage and the tea bar was a garden shed. The field was later sold as part of major development land and only intense lobbying led by the then Chairman, Mike Packer persuaded the Council to allocate Springfield as part of Public Open Space leased to the Football Club for dual use.

The Club won the Gloucestershire county League championship in 1971-72, 1972-73, 73 74 and runners up 74/75 at the same time winning the GFA Senior Amateur Cup in 1972/73 73/74 and 1974-75. The success pushed the club into joining the Midland Combination after being turned down by the Western League due to the dressing rooms being situated too far from the. A stand was built for the requirement of the Midland Combination (with tea bar). After finishing fifth and reaching the quarter finals of the FA Vase with a crowd of 2,000 at Springfield for the tie against Billericay Town from Essex, the Manager left after a disagreement with the committee, and took most of the players, to Cinderford Town. This shook the club to the core, we were relegated and had to drop two divisions to the Avon Premier Combination. A slow recovery took place with further development of the ground taking advantage of newly laid drains for the new houses. Elected back into the Gloucestershire County League in 1984 a reserve team was started in the first team finished as runners-up in the County League in 1990. The Club celebrated their

Centenary by winning the League Championship for the fifth time in 1994 and continued to dominate the league once again. Continued improvement on and off the field saw new dressing rooms built on the ground in 1997, a youth academy started. After winning the Gloucestershire County League for a record sixth time, an application to join the Western League was again turned down due to the lack of a fence. After a public open meeting and a long battle with the Council, the fence was finally erected at a cost of £15,000 funded by Cadbury Heath Football Club. Steve and Lee's first season in charge got runners up spot, of which consequently secured our election to the Toolstation Western League at long last!

After 2 seasons in charge, Steve Plenty stood down due to family commitments and Lee Knighton took over the hot seat for a season and then the reigns were handed over to his assistant, Glen Smart, who consolidated our position for four seasons. Lee Knighton took over as First Team Manager for his second spell and appointed Andy Weeks as his assistant in season 2005/6, also that year Steve Plenty became Chairman when Dave Smart stood down.

After five years of planning tribulations Floodlights were successfully installed at the end of season 2008/2009 this being Phase one of Heaths redevelopment plan, being largely due to the efforts of Chairman Steve Plenty. The Heath and The Social Club went their separate ways in season 2011/12. Andy Black joined the club for his third spell in season 2010/11 appointing Glenn Smart as his assistant culminating in the first division championship and promotion to the Premier Div. in season 2011/12.

Then followed two good seasons in the premier division with the last two seasons being a period of trying to rebuild the side after most of the original players either retiring or moving on to higher level football. Phase two, is in the planning stage which is for a new dressing room facility incorporating a new clubhouse & new 100 seat stand with a covered area for a further 100. During season 2015-2016 Roger Coke joined the club as coach. Season 2016-2017 started with a new first team coach Phillip Bater Ex Bristol Rovers and the introduction of a U18 side who play in the Bristol & Glos U18 league. Mid-season Rob Mallett joined the coaching staff to assist Andy Black. First team won the GFA Challenge Trophy beating Fairfield Town 4-3 On penalties. End of season Andy Black resigned as manager and became director of football. Season 2017-2018, Rob Mallett was appointed first team manager. Season 2018-2019 Andy Black was appointed first team manager. 2019-2020 John Black joined the management team. Season 2020-2021 Mitchell Hodge was appointed first team manager assisted by Aaron Day. Season 2021-2022 George Boon, David Doe & Matt Huxley were appointed joint managers.






