WELLINGTON AFC Club History

Formed in 1892, we are proud to be an FA Accredited Club. Initially, the club played in leagues based around Taunton and Tiverton. In the early 1960s, we gained promotion to the Somerset Senior League and succeeded in achieving Western League status in 1978 which has been retained ever since, making us one of the league's longest continuously-serving members.

The First Team entered the Western League in the First Division in the 1978-79 season and played at Premier Division level from 1981-82 to 1984-85 and 2008-09 to 2010-11. The team were then promoted as First Division Champions at the end of the 2016-17 season. In their first season back in the Premier Division, the team finished a creditable 15th and also reached the semi-final of the Somerset Premier Cup losing 4-1 away to Southern League club Paulton Rovers. The following season, the team finished in 16th place but unfortunately, the next two campaigns were brought to an early conclusion by the Coronavirus pandemic.

Last season provided new challenges for the team, including starting the season with a trip to Mousehole and a final match at Helston on Easter Monday. The side achieved their highest position in the Toolstation Premier League since the 2009-10 season (14th) and equaled the club's longest run in the FA Vase (third round). The 2022-23 season again presents new challenges and new grounds to visit with teams being promoted to and relegated into the Premier Division. Joint managers Tim Legg and Alex Pope are again in charge of the side.

The Reserves were top of Division One West in the Devon and Exeter League when the 2020-21 season was terminated due to the Covid pandemic. The league took the opportunity to restructure for the start of the 2021-22 season and move away from the East and West Divisions and, as a result, the Reserves were placed in Division One where they finished in fifth place. Although there has been some movement of teams within the league the Reserves, under new manager, Nick Buttle, have remained in Division One for this season.

Having played in the Devon and Exeter League for a number of seasons, the A team transferred to Division Three of the Taunton Saturday League for the 2018-19 season when they finished a creditable third, gaining promotion to

Division Two for the 2019-20 season. They gained further promotion to Division One for the 2020-21 season and were topping the table when the season was forced to end due to the Covid pandemic. They won their group in the league's Covid Cup and also won the Seward Cup held over from 2019-20. Last season they finished in fifth place and, under manager Warren Toth, are in Division One again this for this campaign.

The club's Ladies played in the Somerset County Women's League Division Two (Flexi) in the 2020-21 season, finishing a creditable third when the season resumed. Last season they again played in Division Two where they finished in second place and reached the quarter-finals of the League Knock-Out Cup. Under manager Nyima Touray, they have been promoted to Division One for the 2022-23 campaign. This season there is also an additional Ladies Development Team, giving the opportunity for players to progress from the Wildcats Under 16s to senior football.

Last season, our youth teams once again performed well in their respective league and cup competitions, notably the Under 14s Town won their division and were runners-up in the league cup while the Under 12s United and Under 15s Town teams both finished runners-up in their division. All the other youth teams, boys and an increasing number of girls, acquitted themselves well and continue to be run by a small army of enthusiastic volunteers.

Our three Disability teams also performed well in their league and, this season, instead of three adult teams, we have two adult teams and a youth team.

In total this season, the club are running no fewer than 33 teams.

We continue to work with the town and district councils to pursue the club's attempts to establish a new First Team facility on land on the new Longforth Farm Estate on the edge of the town. This would then free-up the Playing Field for other teams to use. We are also working with the Wellington Sports Federation on the Somerset West and Taunton Playing Pitch Strategy regarding other land in the town where it is proposed a number of youth sports pitches would be provided.

Outside our core footballing activities, Wellington AFC is home to several darts and skittles teams and we run a full programme of social events for members and non-members alike with the impressive Function Room and Lounge available for hire.

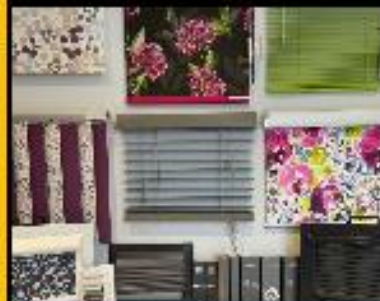

MATCH REPORT

WELLINGTON 2 1 CADBURY HEATH

Wellington AFC climbed further up the premier division table with their second win in four days at the Playing Field last Saturday (11th February)

After falling behind to an early goal, an improved second half performance saw the Tangerines come from behind to take the points.

Wellington made only one change from the starting 11 who played so well in the midweek victory over Barnstaple Town – keeper Harley Wilkinson returning to replace Shay Allen. But against a side below them in the table they got off to the worst possible start as Cadbury Heath went ahead in controversial circumstances after only four minutes.

Wilkinson was challenged as he leapt to collect a high ball into the box and could only push it out for Ali Boyer to net with the home side appealing in vain for a foul.

Wellington struggled to get into their stride for the rest of the half although they did go close on a number of occasions without being able to get back on terms, while they were indebted to Wilkinson for a sharp block from a rare Cadbury Heath break.

The home side introduced Eli Collins for Glen Wright at the interval and equalised two minutes after the restart when a trademark long throw from Jack Bown-Porter saw Jason Quick score with a flicked header which looped into the net.

Wellington made three more substitutions around the hour mark including the introduction of Tom Burt, a new signing from Bovey Tracey of the SW Peninsular League. And, despite being a man short for ten minutes after Ryan Brereton was sin-binned, it was Burt who proved to be the match-winner on 70 minutes as a lofted free kick dropped to him and his low drive crept inside the post.

Wellington could have increased their lead in the closing stages but sub Sully McKenna headed against the woodwork and then the hard-working Miles Quick fired over from close range.

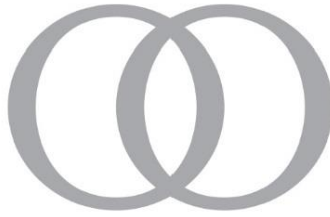

TODAY'S VISITORS STREET

We extend a warm welcome to the players, officials and supporters of Street for today's Toolstation League Premier Division game.

Founded in 1880, **Street Football Club** is one of the oldest Association Football clubs in Somerset and were given the nickname 'The Cobblers' due to the large shoemaking industry in the village and surrounding area. Playing at county level for the first quarter of its history, the Club won the Somerset Senior League 5 times and the Somerset FA Senior Cup 3 times before making its first foray into the Western League a few seasons before the onset of World War One.

For the remainder of the 20th century Street FC yo-yoed between the Western League and the Somerset Senior League winning a few honours along the way.

The Club also had its best FA Cup runs during this period by reaching the First Round Proper twice, once either side of World War Two; in 1938 away to Ipswich Town and 1947 at Cheltenham Town - after beating Yeovil Town 2-1 in front of a record 5,000 crowd at The Victoria Field in the previous round.

The closest the Club came to winning the Western League Championship during the 20th century was in season 1952-53 when they were pipped to the title by Barnstaple Town, who had a 0.01 better goal average after the sides had finished level on 44 points each. However, leaner times returned and the Club soon found itself back at county level once more.

Season 1996-97 saw the Club win the Somerset Senior League for a record eighth time, thus gaining promotion back to the Western League after a 37-year absence. Ten years later, after gaining promotion to the Premier Division in season 2005-06, the Club had its best run in The FA Vase when reaching the Fifth Round Proper before losing at Wimborne Town.

After finishing as Premier Division Runners-up the previous season, the 2017-18 campaign was the Club's 50th in the Western League, and was a momentous one too! Early results were inconsistent: but starting on 12th September, manager Richard Fey's charges completed a sensational run of **26 consecutive league victories** that eventually saw the team win the title by 15 points (falling just one point short of the century) after winning 32 of their 38 games and scoring 100 goals, thus earning a place in the Southern Football League for the first time in the Club's 138-year history.

However, 2018-19 was to be the only season at the higher level for the Club as it soon became clear that Southern League football was a 'step too far': and despite a respectable seventh-place finish, the decision was taken to protect the long-term future of the Club and return to the Toolstation Western League.

Since the beginning of season 2019-20 the Club has changed its emphasis and opted to recruit a management team and playing squad that focusses more on youth and local player development and progression.

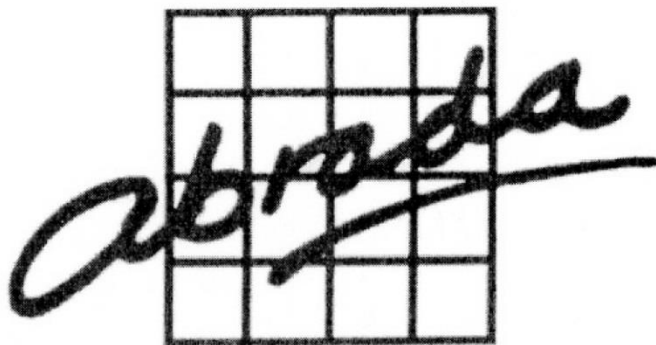

Premier Division: Mousehole's winning streak in the league has now stretched to nine matches after they surged to a 3-0 victory at home to **Ashton & Backwell United**. Wellington mirrored Barnstaple's comeback efforts, scoring twice after the interval to topple **Cadbury Heath** in Somerset. Having fallen behind after just five minutes to an Ali Boyer strike, Welly came out firing after the interval and drew level within two minutes of the restart thanks to Jason Quick. It was a deflected effort from Tom Burt which decided the contest 20 minutes from time, with the hosts making it two wins in the space of four days, showing great resolve after they had suffered a couple of tough defeats in recent weeks

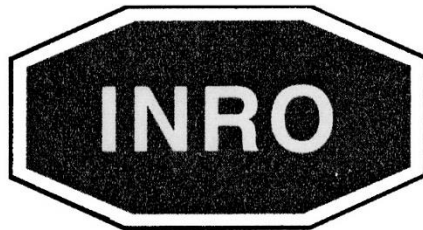

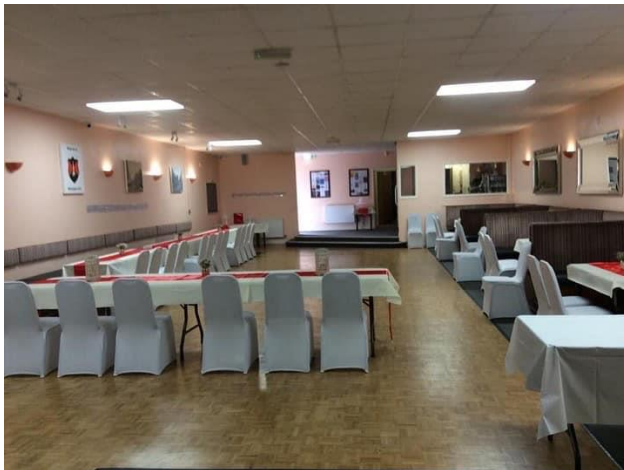
