CODE OF CONDUCT FOR SPECTATORS



As a Charter Standard Club we expect all spectators to play your part and support the FA's Code of Respect:

- Never engage in or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language
- Never engage in threatening or violent behaviour
- Never engage in racist abuse or behaviour of any kind
- Never abuse match or team officials from either side
- Stay behind the touchline and within the designated spectator's area

You must fully understand and readily accept that failure to comply with any of the above may result in you being:

- Issued with a verbal warning or asked to leave
- Required to meet with the club committee, league or Welfare Officer
- Obligated to undertake and FA education course
- Requested not to attend future games, be suspended or have your membership removed
- Required to leave the club along with any dependents and/or issued a fine.
