WELLINGTON AFC Club History

Formed in 1892, we are proud to be an FA Accredited Club. Initially, the club played in leagues based around Taunton and Tiverton. In the early 1960s, we gained promotion to the Somerset Senior League and succeeded in achieving Western League status in 1978 which has been retained ever since, making us one of the league's longest continuously-serving members.

The First Team entered the Western League in the First Division in the 1978-79 season and played at Premier Division level from 1981-82 to 1984-85 and 2008-09 to 2010-11. The team were then promoted as First Division Champions at the end of the 2016-17 season. In their first season back in the Premier Division, the team finished a creditable 15th and also reached the semi-final of the Somerset Premier Cup losing 4-1 away to Southern League club Paulton Rovers. The following season, the team finished in 16th place but unfortunately, the next two campaigns were brought to an early conclusion by the Coronavirus pandemic.

Last season provided new challenges for the team, including starting the season with a trip to Mousehole and a final match at Helston on Easter Monday. The side achieved their highest position in the Toolstation Premier League since the 2009-10 season (14th) and equaled the club's longest run in the FA Vase (third round). The 2022-23 season again presents new challenges and new grounds to visit with teams being promoted to and relegated into the Premier Division. Joint managers Tim Legg and Alex Pope are again in charge of the side.

The Reserves were top of Division One West in the Devon and Exeter League when the 2020-21 season was terminated due to the Covid pandemic. The league took the opportunity to restructure for the start of the 2021-22 season and move away from the East and West Divisions and, as a result, the Reserves were placed in Division One where they finished in fifth place. Although there has been some movement of teams within the league the Reserves, under new manager, Nick Buttle, have remained in Division One for this season.

Having played in the Devon and Exeter League for a number of seasons, the A team transferred to Division Three of the Taunton Saturday League for the 2018-19 season when they finished a creditable third, gaining promotion to

Division Two for the 2019-20 season. They gained further promotion to Division One for the 2020-21 season and were topping the table when the season was forced to end due to the Covid pandemic. They won their group in the league's Covid Cup and also won the Seward Cup held over from 2019-20. Last season they finished in fifth place and, under manager Warren Toth, are in Division One again this for this campaign.

The club's Ladies played in the Somerset County Women's League Division Two (Flexi) in the 2020-21 season, finishing a creditable third when the season resumed. Last season they again played in Division Two where they finished in second place and reached the quarter-finals of the League Knock-Out Cup. Under manager Nyima Touray, they have been promoted to Division One for the 2022-23 campaign. This season there is also an additional Ladies Development Team, giving the opportunity for players to progress from the Wildcats Under 16s to senior football.

Last season, our youth teams once again performed well in their respective league and cup competitions, notably the Under 14s Town won their division and were runners-up in the league cup while the Under 12s United and Under 15s Town teams both finished runners-up in their division. All the other youth teams, boys and an increasing number of girls, acquitted themselves well and continue to be run by a small army of enthusiastic volunteers.

Our three Disability teams also performed well in their league and, this season, instead of three adult teams, we have two adult teams and a youth team.

In total this season, the club are running no fewer than 33 teams.

We continue to work with the town and district councils to pursue the club's attempts to establish a new First Team facility on land on the new Longforth Farm Estate on the edge of the town. This would then free-up the Playing Field for other teams to use. We are also working with the Wellington Sports Federation on the Somerset West and Taunton Playing Pitch Strategy regarding other land in the town where it is proposed a number of youth sports pitches would be provided.

Outside our core footballing activities, Wellington AFC is home to several darts and skittles teams and we run a full programme of social events for members and non-members alike with the impressive Function Room and Lounge available for hire.

WELLINGTON 1 1 HELSTON ATHLETIC

Wellington bounced back from two defeats with a hard-earned point against sixth-placed Helston Athletic on Tuesday (25th April).

Because the Playing Field lights have been taken down for the cricket season, the match was played at fellow premier club Buckland Athletic on the outskirts of Newton Abbot.

The Tangerines – facing two games in three days – made six changes from the starting 11 who lost 3-0 away to new champions Mousehole on Saturday (22nd April). They had been without either of their regular keepers in Cornwall and welcomed back Shay Allen who gave an assured display.

The game sprang to life after 18 minutes with incidents at both ends.

Helston's Rikki Shepherd lifted the ball over the bar when he looked certain to score and Wellington broke straight away.

Tom Burt slipped the ball through to Jake Quick and the striker coolly rounded keeper Mike Searle before slotting home the opener.

Helston claimed they had equalised just after the half-hour when a powerful header by Rubin Wilson was clawed out by Allen but their appeals that the ball had crossed the line were turned down.

Wilson was not to be denied though and made it 1-1 ten minutes into the second half as he was played into space in the box and advanced before driving low past Allen.

They got the ball into the net again four minutes later from a far post header by Shepherd but this time the flag was up for offside.


Helston continued in search of the winner but some resolute defending by Wellington, who used all five subs, kept them at bay.

TODAY'S VISITORS ILFRACOMBE TOWN

We extend a warm welcome to the players, officials and supporters of Ilfracombe Town for tonight's Toolstation League Premier Division game.

Ilfracombe football club was formed in November 1902 and played local opposition until the formation of the North Devon League in 1904, in which Combe became one of the founder members. The present name of Ilfracombe Town was adopted in 1920, the club contested the East Devon League remaining there for many years.

The present ground of Marlborough Park was acquired in 1923 and laid out for competitive football in 1924/25 season. In 1949 Western League football was applied for and the club was admitted entry into division 3 for the season 1949/50, winning promotion as runner up at the end of that year. During the 1952/53 season the clubs finest FA Cup run was experienced by the only Division 2 team to reach the fourth qualifying round where Llanelli was the venue and the result was 1-0 in favour of the Welshmen in front of an 8500 gate.

Promotion to Division 1 was also achieved at the end of the 52/53 season but after two years relegation was followed by poor results and poor support ultimately resulting in withdrawal from the league by the 1958/59 season.

During the 60s and 70s North Devon League football was again contested and during the early 80s, after some very encouraging seasons it was decided to re-apply for Western League football and reentry was accepted from the 1984/85 season.

Since re-joining the Western League the club contested Division 1 for many seasons and promotion was eventually achieved to the Premier Division at the end of the 2006/07 season and Step 5 football was maintained with the winning of the Les Phillips Challenge Cup in the

2010/11 season, after 30 years of membership the club decided to leave the Western League at the end of the 2012/13 season.

North Devon League football was once again contested with the first team in the Premier Division and the Reserves in the Senior Division and the 3rd Team in Intermediate 1, at the end of the 2016/17 season all 3 teams won promotion and with the Ladies team achieving promotion a very successful season was enjoyed.

The 2017/18 season Combe joined the South West Peninsula East Division, and after a couple of good seasons the team was going very well when the season was curtailed because of COVID-19, they were moved up into the Western League Premier Division for the 2021/22 season when the Non-League system was re-organised.





EXTRACT FROM TOOLSTATION BULLETIN – 23RD APRIL 2023 PREMIER DIVISION

Playing under the upmost pressure on Saturday, **Mousehole** secured the three points which took them to the title thanks to a 3-0 victory at home to **Wellington**. Knowing that a win would see them confirm top spot, Mousehole eased any nerves they may have in the opening stages when Andy Elcock broke the deadlock after just 15 minutes. A second strike soon after from Callam McOnie put the Seagulls two goals to the good, before leading scorer Hayden Turner confirmed the victory ten minutes from time, capping an outstanding season for both himself and the team

Runners-up **Saltash** will be forced to navigate the playoffs after falling just short in their title push. Despite winning seven of their final eight league games, the Ashes were unable to push themselves into top spot and finished two points in arrears. Their final win of the campaign came in relatively simple circumstances, with four different goalscorers helping them see off **Shepton Mallet** down in Cornwall. The

hosts absolutely shot out of the blocks, with Adam Carter and Carlo Garside putting them two-up inside the opening ten minutes. A further goal from Harrison Davis extended Saltash's advantage after 25 minutes, with Sam Hughes then capping the victory during a quiet second half period.

In the top-four battle at Fairfax Park, **Bridgwater** defeated **Buckland** 2-0 to leapfrog their visitors for the time being. Playing their final league game of the season, Bridgy had plenty to play for, and they showed that during the opening stages with Jack Thorne firing them ahead after 18 minutes. A further goal in the closing stages from Tom Llewellyn extended United's advantage, and it could have been even more one-sided if it hadn't been for a late penalty save from Buckland keeper Andy Collings.

There was also a fare bit of success for a number of away sides, including **Millbrook** who put five past **Cadbury Heath**. Having gone ahead inside the opening minute, Millbrook were pegged back a couple of moments later when Ali Boyer levelled for the hosts. That was as good as it got for the home side however, and after Josh Toulson slotted home a penalty to restore Millbrook's lead, they then struck three times in the final 20 minutes through Tylor Love-Holmes, Kieran O'Melia and Jack Wood to end their season with aplomb.

Helston are finishing the season incredibly strongly, and they secured another three points on Saturday, with Rikki Sheppard, Sam Carter and Rubin Wilson all finding the back of the net during their 3-1 win away at **Keynsham**, for whom Dylan Lewis grabbed a late consolation.
