## WELLINGTON AFC Club History

Formed in 1892, we are proud to be an FA Accredited Club. Initially, the club played in leagues based around Taunton and Tiverton. In the early 1960s, we gained promotion to the Somerset Senior League and succeeded in achieving Western League status in 1978 which has been retained ever since, making us one of the league's longest continuously-serving members.

The First Team entered the Western League in the First Division in the 1978-79 season and played at Premier Division level from 1981-82 to 1984-85 and 2008-09 to 2010-11. The team were then promoted as First Division Champions at the end of the 2016-17 season. In their first season back in the Premier Division, the team finished a creditable 15th and also reached the semi-final of the Somerset Premier Cup losing 4-1 away to Southern League club Paulton Rovers. The following season, the team finished in 16th place but unfortunately, the next two campaigns were brought to an early conclusion by the Coronavirus pandemic.

Last season provided new challenges for the team, including starting the season with a trip to Mousehole and a final match at Helston on Easter Monday. The side achieved their highest position in the Toolstation Premier League since the 2009-10 season (14th) and equaled the club's longest run in the FA Vase (third round). The 2022-23 season again presents new challenges and new grounds to visit with teams being promoted to and relegated into the Premier Division. Joint managers Tim Legg and Alex Pope are again in charge of the side.

The Reserves were top of Division One West in the Devon and Exeter League when the 2020-21 season was terminated due to the Covid pandemic. The league took the opportunity to restructure for the start of the 2021-22 season and move away from the East and West Divisions and, as a result, the Reserves were placed in Division One where they finished in fifth place. Although there has been some movement of teams within the league the Reserves, under new manager, Nick Buttle, have remained in Division One for this season.

Having played in the Devon and Exeter League for a number of seasons, the A team transferred to Division Three of the Taunton Saturday League for the 2018-19 season when they finished a creditable third, gaining promotion to

Division Two for the 2019-20 season. They gained further promotion to Division One for the 2020-21 season and were topping the table when the season was forced to end due to the Covid pandemic. They won their group in the league's Covid Cup and also won the Seward Cup held over from 2019-20. Last season they finished in fifth place and, under manager Warren Toth, are in Division One again this for this campaign.

The club's Ladies played in the Somerset County Women's League Division Two (Flexi) in the 2020-21 season, finishing a creditable third when the season resumed. Last season they again played in Division Two where they finished in second place and reached the quarter-finals of the League Knock-Out Cup. Under manager Nyima Touray, they have been promoted to Division One for the 2022-23 campaign. This season there is also an additional Ladies Development Team, giving the opportunity for players to progress from the Wildcats Under 16s to senior football.

Last season, our youth teams once again performed well in their respective league and cup competitions, notably the Under 14s Town won their division and were runners-up in the league cup while the Under 12s United and Under 15s Town teams both finished runners-up in their division. All the other youth teams, boys and an increasing number of girls, acquitted themselves well and continue to be run by a small army of enthusiastic volunteers.

Our three Disability teams also performed well in their league and, this season, instead of three adult teams, we have two adult teams and a youth team.

In total this season, the club are running no fewer than 33 teams.

We continue to work with the town and district councils to pursue the club's attempts to establish a new First Team facility on land on the new Longforth Farm Estate on the edge of the town. This would then free-up the Playing Field for other teams to use. We are also working with the Wellington Sports Federation on the Somerset West and Taunton Playing Pitch Strategy regarding other land in the town where it is proposed a number of youth sports pitches would be provided.

Outside our core footballing activities, Wellington AFC is home to several darts and skittles teams and we run a full programme of social events for members and non-members alike with the impressive Function Room and Lounge available for hire.

## MATCH REPORT

**WELLINGTON            0            1            BUCKLAND ATHLETIC**

Ten-man Wellington could hold their heads high after an odd-goal Good Friday defeat by sixth-placed Buckland at the Playing Field.

The game turned on the controversial sending off of Nathan Byrne eight minutes before half-time but the Tangerines still deserved at least a point.

It was the second of four games in just over a week for Wellington and they again rotated their squad including a welcome return from injury for defender Stefan Philips.

After a lively start, it looked like Buckland would take the lead when they were awarded a penalty for handball after 27 minutes. The ball cannoned off Wellington's Ryan Brereton and the referee pointed to the spot only for ex-Taunton Town striker Jared Lewington to put his kick wide of the post.

However, they were not to be denied and went ahead four minutes later when Lewington's strike partner Ryan Bush got the benefit of a rebound in the box and drove low past keeper Harley Wilkinson.

Wellington were then shocked by Byrne's dismissal in the 37th minute. Buckland broke out of defence and the midfielder pulled down one of their players on the edge of the centre circle. The referee decided he was the last man and produced a red card turning away home protests that there were defenders getting back to cover.

Despite their numerical disadvantage, Wellington went on to boss the rest of the game without being able to get back on terms.

Will Armstrong, only 17, played the whole of the second half while another Reserves player, leading scorer Rohan Poulosom, also stepped off the bench and the pair acquitted themselves well.



Wilkinson didn't have a save to make until a superb double block in the closing minutes while both Tom Stone and Jake Quick went close as the hosts left Buckland hanging on to their slender advantage. Wellington also had vehement appeals for a penalty for handball turned down after 72 minutes - it just wasn't to be their day.

## CADBURY HEATH 1 5 WELLINGTON

Wellington ended their run of defeats and completed the double over struggling Cadbury Heath with a 5-1 win in Bristol on Easter Monday. The game was ruined by a strong wind and heavy pitch but the Tangerines' clinical finishing sealed three welcome points.

Cadbury Heath, who have slipped to the bottom of the table, looked more dangerous early on but Wellington went ahead from their first effort on goal in the 31st minute. A trademark long throw by Jack Bown-Porter came off the head of a home defender and Ryan Brereton ran in to nod home.

Just as it looked like Wellington would go into the break ahead, the hosts equalised on the stroke of half-time when a cross from the left was headed home at the far post by Matt Isaacs.

The Tangerines responded to the setback with two goals in the first eight minutes of the second half.

They regained the lead two minutes after the restart when the ball broke to Alfie Clark on the left of the area and he cut inside before scoring with a fierce drive.

Shortly afterwards it was 3-1 as some fine play ended with Eli Collins playing in Jake Quick who deftly slipped the ball past the keeper and in off the post.

Cadbury Heath also had their chances but were unable to reduce the deficit before being finished off by two pieces of individual brilliance from Jamie Nicholson.

After 72 minutes, he weaved his way to the byline before shooting home from the narrowest of angles. He then struck again with two minutes remaining, this time receiving a pass from Collins before wriggling into space and shooting low into the net.

The five-goal salvo will give Wellington a confidence boost ahead of their fourth game in eight days this evening against Ilfracombe Town.

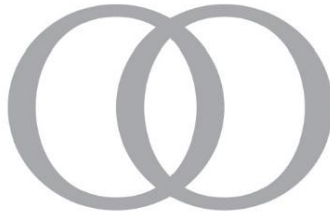

## TODAY'S VISITORS TORPOINT ATHLETIC

We extend a warm welcome to the players, officials and supporters of Torpoint Athletic for today's Toolstation League Premier Division game.

Torpoint Athletic joined the South Western League in Season 1962/63 the club was fortunate to have many local players within the team.

They won the South Western League Championship on two occasions 1964/65 and 1966/67. The club won the Charity Cup on three occasions 1966, 1967 and 1968. Torpoint Athletic lost in the final of the South Western League Cup in 1965/66 and the Cornwall Senior Cup in 1967/68. The club competed in the FA Amateur Cup reaching the second round on several occasions

Altogether eleven enjoyable years were spent at Defiance Field. The ground had an end to end slope with good playing surface that encouraged good football. The support was good with crowds often of over a thousand watching matches, especially during the Amateur Cup runs. However, it was always a wish of the club to return to what many considered to be the traditional home of local football in Torpoint "The Mill". In 1970 the option to buy "The Mill" was offered to the club.

The committee led by Chairman Mr Reg. Devonshire and Secretary Keith Lillyman formed the "Two Hundred Club". This weekly and monthly draw helped the club raise the finance required. In 1971 Torpoint Athletic purchased "The Mill". The grand opening of the pitch took place on Wednesday August 11<sup>th</sup> 1971. Torpoint Athletic played a County Eleven losing the match by three goals to two.

During the nineties the club competed in the FA Vase competition. They played against sides such as Chippenham Town, Diss Town, Eastleigh, Exmouth and Tunbridge Wells. In the season 1995/96 the club had it's best run in the competition losing to Raunds Town two nil in the fifth round. Unfortunately as the competition required clubs to have floodlights Torpoint were unable to enter the competition until 09/10 season.

The club remained in the South Western League until its final season in 06/07. Torpoint got promoted in last minute of the game when Darren Hicks scored to beat Penryn Athletic 3-2 in a very exciting game.



From season 2008/09 the Club played in the South West Peninsula Premier Division East and finished League Champions in 2021/22 which meant promotion to the Western League, Premier Division (Step 5), the highest level Torpoint Athletic have ever played at.

In last season's cup competitions they got to the FA Vase 2nd Round Proper, competed in the Cornwall Senior Cup and they won the Walter C Parson Cup Final, beating St Blazey 3-1 at Pennygillam, completing a League & League Cup double. In their last match of the season Torpoint played in the WCP Champions Bowl against SWPL Premier Division Champions Falmouth Town and lost 4-2 at Priory Park, Bodmin Town.

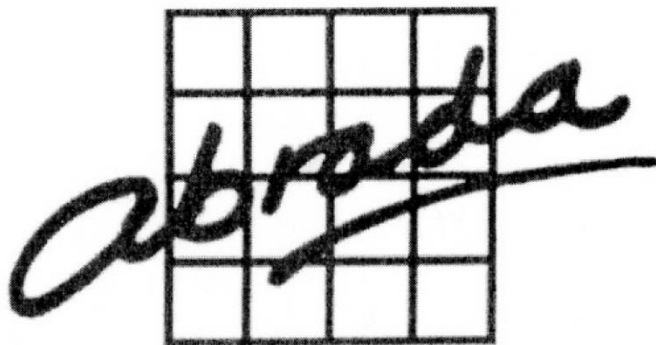

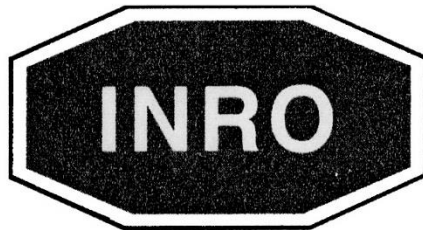

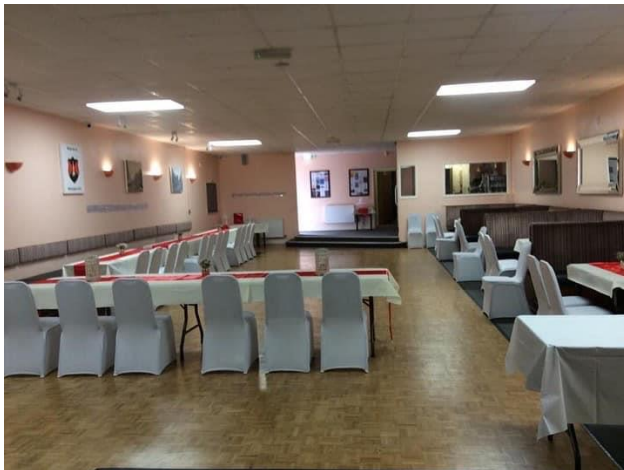
