WELLINGTON AFC Club History

Formed in 1892, we are proud to be a three-star FA Accredited Club and run more than 30 teams, providing football for hundreds and men, women, boys and girls throughout the season.

Initially, the club played in leagues based around Taunton and Tiverton. In the early 1960s, we gained promotion to the Somerset Senior League and succeeded in achieving Western League status in 1978 which has been retained ever since, making us one of the league's longest continuously serving members.

Since entering entered the Western League in the First Division, we have played at Premier Division level from 1981-82 to 1984-85 and 2008-09 to 2010-11. The team were then promoted as First Division champions at the end of the 2016-17 season and have since remained in the Premier Division.

In their first season back in the Premier Division, the team finished a creditable 15th and also reached the semi-finals of the Somerset Premier Cup. The side, who ended up 15th in 2022-23, are now managed by Richard Cherry, assisted by long-serving defender Jack Bown-Porter.

We have four other senior sides - the Reserves in the Devon and Exeter League's Division One, the A team in the Taunton Saturday League's Division One and the Ladies, who have two teams in the Somerset County Women's League.

We run 23 teams in our youth and minis with both boys and girls playing from the age of eight right through to 18 - along with coaching for even younger children.

We also have a thriving Disability section with two adult sides and a youth team.

Off the pitch, Wellington AFC play a major role in the local community – we are home to a large number of skittles and darts teams and our social facilities are in use throughout the year for a wide range of events staged by local organisations, registered charities and individuals.

BIDEFORD

Bideford AFC were first formed in the 1890's as Bideford Town and nicknamed "The Robins" due to their red shirts. Since the first decade of the twentieth century the club have predominantly played at the Sports Ground, Kingsley Road in Bideford. Until entering hibernation for the duration of World War Two, Bideford were a highly successful club in the North Devon district.

Following their reformation in the 1947/48 season, the club was reborn as Bideford Association Football Club and entered the Exeter & East Devon League. Bideford were runners up in the 1948/49 season and joined Western League Division Three. The Robins won the division without losing a game and two seasons later they won the second division and promotion to Division One.

In 1964/65 Bideford reached the first-round proper of the FA Cup and were drawn away at Colchester United. The game finished 3-3 before losing the replay at home 1-2 with the BBC cameras present. Bideford won the Western League title three times before joining the Southern League in 1972. The club spent three seasons in Division One South before being forced to step back down to the Western League due to the increase in travelling and expenses. The club set an all-time FA Cup record when in 1974–75 they played thirteen FA Cup games in a single season – as a result of playing numerous replays in qualifying rounds including needing five games to beat Falmouth Town and four more to beat Trowbridge Town in the next round. With the subsequent abandonment of second and further replays, this record is unlikely to ever be beaten again. Bideford were finally knocked out 0-2 by Bristol Rovers. In 1977/78 Bideford again reached the First-Round proper travelling to Portsmouth where they lost 1-3. Finally, they achieved the feat again in 1981/82 being knocked out by Barking 1-2.

Two more Western League titles followed in the early 1980s before a financial crisis hit the club. A re-formation took place in 1987 leading to the current set up, a company limited by guarantee under the revised company name Bideford AFC (1987) Ltd.

Under the chairmanship of Jim McElwee and his successor Paul Mitchell, the club won four more Western League titles and also reached the FA Vase semi-finals where they lost to Winchester City. Despite winning the Western League four times under manager Sean Joyce between 2000 and 2006, the club elected not to apply for promotion to the Southern League due to the amount of travelling and expense.

However, after winning the Western League again for the 10th time in the 2009/10 season and winning the Devon St Luke's Bowl where they beat Exeter City 2–1 in the final, Bideford accepted promotion to the Southern League in May 2010 joining Division One South & West. In only their second season in Division One (S&W) Bideford were crowned champions by an impressive eleven-point margin and gained promotion for the first time in the club's history to the Southern League Premier Division. 2013/14 saw Bideford finish in their highest ever league position of 8th in the Premier Division but after four years at that level they were relegated for the first time in their history back to Division One South in 2015/16. Bideford won the Devon St Luke's Bowl for a sixth time in 2022 by once again beating Exeter City.

Several players from the club have progressed to Football League status, the most recent of them being Tony Dennis and Shaun Taylor. Three former internationals have played for the club at the end of their career, Welshman Leighton Phillips, Dermot Curtis and Will Haynes from the Republic of Ireland.


Bideford have won the Western League ten times, as well as lifting silverware in the Devon St Luke's Bowl (6 times), Devon Professional Cup (8 times) and Western League Cup (4 times). They have also won the Western League Alan Young Cup (twice), Western League Subsidiary Cup and the Westward Ho! cup. In FA competitions, Bideford have reached the First-Round proper of the FA Cup on four occasions and reached the semi-final of the FA Vase in 2003/04.

Manager Sean Joyce is an ex-professional footballer, who spent his career playing for Doncaster Rovers, Exeter City and Torquay Utd. Joyce took over the role of manager in 1998 with the club really struggling in the Western League and has gone on to guide Bideford to five Western League titles, the Southern League Division One South title, the Western League cup and two Devon St Luke's Bowls.

MATCH REPORT HELSTON ATHLETIC 2 2 WELLINGTON

Wellington started life under the new management team of Richard Cherry and Jack Bown-Porter with a stunning fightback away to Helston Athletic last Saturday, 29th July.

With a number of players having left the club during the close season, their starting 11 included three new signings with five more on the bench. All eight youngsters played their part in an outstanding team display against a side tipped by many to be among the title contenders this season.

There wasn't much to choose between the teams in the opening 20 minutes but then Wellington suffered a blow as new skipper Ryan Brereton limped off and was replaced by Beckham Pyatt.

It got worse as Helston struck twice in six minutes before the break, going ahead as the ball was played through to Rikki Shepherd and he neatly clipped it past Mike Murphy, standing in as keeper with Shay Allen on holiday.

When the hosts doubled their advantage shortly afterwards – Rubin Wilson tapping home from close range – it left Wellington with a mountain to climb.

But they picked themselves up after the break to knock Helston out of their stride as the hosts' attacking intent was blunted by some stubborn defending and a couple of smart stops by Murphy.

Despite losing two more players to injury, Wellington gave themselves a glimmer of hope by pulling a goal back just after the hour mark. Helston failed to clear their lines and debutant James Cottrill's drive found the net with the help of a wicked deflection.

With six minutes remaining, the Tangerines completed their recovery with a second goal. Striker Rohan Poulsom was felled in the box and assistant boss Bown-Porter stepped up to thump home the resulting penalty.

There was even a twist in the tail during seven minutes of injury time as Helston sub Kai Cornish looked certain to net the winner but dragged his shot wide with several of his teammates throwing themselves to the ground in despair as he missed the target.

The final whistle sounded shortly afterwards to make it a happy coach journey home for the Tangerines' players, management team and supporters.

MATCH REPORT SHEPTON MALLET 2 0 WELLINGTON

Wellington's new-look squad were unable to reproduce the heroics of their opening game as they lost at Shepton Mallet on Tuesday, (1^{st} August). They trailed 2-0 at the break – the same as at Helston where they eventually drew 2-2 – but this time they were unable to reduce the arrears.

The Tangerines fielded four more debutants but were without new skipper Ryan Brereton who suffered a fractured ankle early on in Cornwall.

They were denied by two goalline clearances in the opening 15 minutes – both from newcomers as Jordan Hayman and Kieran Ireland went close.

But Shepton then took control with two goals before the break. Josh Jenkins ran onto a through ball to give them the lead after 20 minutes and, 15 minutes later, Will Banks scored with a thumping header.

To their credit, Wellington came out fighting for the second half and were unlucky not to get back in the game early on.

Another debutant, Josh Lukins saw a free kick deflected on to the post and, shortly afterwards, they had appeals for a penalty turned down when Lloyd Tucker was sent tumbling in the home box.

Lukins also brought a fine save out of home keeper Callum Heal with 20 minutes remaining but, six minutes later, Wellington were reduced to ten men when Ireland was shown what looked to be a harsh second yellow.

That killed the game and the Tangerines defended well to prevent a bigger deficit with new keeper Owen Vosper also pulling off a couple of excellent saves.


