#### WELLINGTON AFC Club History

Formed in 1892, we are proud to be a three-star FA Accredited Club and run more than 30 teams, providing football for hundreds and men, women, boys and girls throughout the season.

Initially, the club played in leagues based around Taunton and Tiverton. In the early 1960s, we gained promotion to the Somerset Senior League and succeeded in achieving Western League status in 1978 which has been retained ever since, making us one of the league's longest continuously serving members.

Since entering entered the Western League in the First Division, we have played at Premier Division level from 1981-82 to 1984-85 and 2008-09 to 2010-11. The team were then promoted as First Division champions at the end of the 2016-17 season and have since remained in the Premier Division.

In their first season back in the Premier Division, the team finished a creditable 15th and also reached the semi-finals of the Somerset Premier Cup. The side, who ended up 15<sup>th</sup> in 2022-23, are now managed by Richard Cherry, assisted by long-serving defender Jack Bown-Porter.

We have four other senior sides - the Reserves in the Devon and Exeter League's Division One, the A team in the Taunton Saturday League's Division One and the Ladies, who have two teams in the Somerset County Women's League.

We run 23 teams in our youth and minis with both boys and girls playing from the age of eight right through to 18 - along with coaching for even younger children.

We also have a thriving Disability section with two adult sides and a youth team.

Off the pitch, Wellington AFC play a major role in the local community – we are home to a large number of skittles and darts teams and our social facilities are in use throughout the year for a wide range of events staged by local organisations, registered charities and individuals.

#### **OKEHAMPTON ARGYLE**

Okehampton Argyle were formed in 1926 by a group of railway workers in Okehampton. In 1929, the club joined the West Devon League.

In 1932, Okehampton entered the Exeter and District League. In 1993, after 61 years in the Devon and Exeter League, the club joined the South Western League for a three-year stint, before moving back to the Devon and Exeter League.

In 2007, the club joined the South West Peninsula League. In 2020, Okehampton joined the Devon League South & West Division for a single season. In 2021, the club was admitted into the South West Peninsula League Premier Division East.

In 2022/23 Okehampton finished runners up in the league and were crowned champions of the Walter C Parsons league Cup thanks to a 4-1 victory over Liskeard.



#### HISTORY OF THE FA VASE



The FA Vase effectively replaced The FA Amateur Cup in 1974. In that year The FA Council had decided to abolish the official distinction between amateur and professional footballers and this meant the end of The Amateur Cup and Amateur Internationals involving England.

In its first season 220 clubs entered, but they did not include those that had dominated in The Amateur Cup. Enfield, Hendon, Dagenham, Skelmersdale United and others at their level were immediately allocated to The FA Trophy.

For the first time in history, small clubs – even village clubs – had the chance of playing in a national final at Wembley. The first Vase finalists were Hoddesdon Town from the Spartan League and Epsom & Ewell from the Surrey Senior League. The Hertfordshire side edged home 2-1 before a crowd of 9,000.

Even a competition as democratic as The Vase had its elite clubs in the early years. Billericay Town, initially of the Essex Senior League, won it three times in four seasons. Halesowen Town, then in the West Midlands Regional League, appeared in three Finals and were successful in two. They even beat a Southall side that had a young Les Ferdinand leading the attack.

Until the new Wembley opened in 2007 the record attendance for a Vase Final was the 26,489 who saw the drawn 1989 Final between Sudbury Town and Tamworth at the old Wembley. Tamworth won the replay 3-0 at Peterborough and Ian Moores, a former Division One player with Tottenham Hotspur, scored one of the goals.

The 2013-14 Vase competition was the 40th in history. Wembley had hosted 34 Finals, Villa Park and St Andrews two each, Upton Park and White Hart Lane one each. Thirty-two different clubs have got their hands on The Vase, donated by former FA Councillor Frank Adams. Whitley Bay led the way with four wins.

Only six teams have won the FA Vase more than once. Whitley Bay are the only team to win the FA Vase three times in successive seasons, while Billericay Town, Tiverton Town and Halesowen Town have won back-to-back titles. As of 2017–18, at least one Northern League team has reached the final for 10 consecutive seasons, with teams from the league winning the title in all but two of those years.

In 2017 Forest Green Rovers became the first FA Vase winners to go on to play in the English Football League, while one former Football League team (Glossop North End) have been beaten finalists.

The current holders of the Vase are Ascot United who beat 2022 winners Newport Pagnell Town 1-0 on Non-League Finals Day at Wembley Stadium.

## MATCH REPORT TORPOINT ATHLETIC 2 1 WELLINGTON

A goal in the dying minutes denied Wellington the point they deserved away to unbeaten Torpoint Athletic on Saturday, August 12th.

The Tangerines were depleted by injuries and holidays, so their line-up featured three more players making their first start plus a welcome return for defender Mark Cornish, who missed most of last season with knee trouble.

But the new-look squad put in a battling performance and were desperately unlucky to return home empty handed.

They should have taken the lead after only two minutes after Miles Quick was sent clear and beat keeper Jordan Duffey but the ball rolled the wrong side of the post.

Torpoint made the breakthrough on the half-hour as a corner was headed on and nodded home by James Rowe.

Wellington refused to let the goal knock them back and grew in confidence during the second half.

Sub Rohan Poulsom and defender Ryan Hibbert both went close before they drew level with nine minutes remaining. A low cross by Jack Bown-Porter was diverted into the path of Poulsom who made no mistake from ten yards.

Wellington almost went ahead five minutes later but Tom Burt was denied by a goal line clearance before Torpoint snatched the points after 88 minutes. The ball was squared to Sean Thomson and he smashed an unstoppable shot past keeper Shay Allen to clinch the points and take them two points clear at the top of the table.

## MATCH REPORT NAILSEA & TICKENHAM 4 0 WELLINGTON

Wellington were forced to play more than half of the game with ten men as they eventually went down to a four-goal defeat at newly promoted Nailsea & Tickenham on Tuesday, August 15<sup>th</sup>.

The Tangerines made three changes to the team who were pipped 2-1 by leaders Torpoint Athletic the previous Saturday. Flynn Smith and Rohan Poulsom stepped up from the bench while Jack Lewis played his first game after rejoining the club from Cullompton Rangers.

There was nothing to choose between the sides in a lively first half before the game's pivotal moment five minutes before half-time. Wellington keeper Shay Allen brought down home striker Lucas Vowles and, after the loose ball had been put wide, the referee awarded a free kick before showing Allen a red card.

Midfielder Miles Quick took over in goal and it was always going to be a massive task to keep the busy hosts at bay. The visitors defended valiantly until Nailsea broke the deadlock after 68 minutes.

After a succession of corners, one of them was headed out as far as Vowles who nodded it back into the net off the post. A tough job became even more difficult for Wellington when Vowles scored from a low free kick with 15 minutes remaining and they used all five subs in an effort to gain some impetus.

Ironically, the Tangerines produced a late flurry in the closing minutes before Nailsea scored twice in injury time to give the hosts a rather flattering margin of victory. Sub Luke Osgood made it 3-0 before Vowles completed his hat-trick right at the death.


