#### WELLINGTON AFC Club History

Formed in 1892, we are proud to be a three-star FA Accredited Club and run more than 30 teams, providing football for hundreds and men, women, boys and girls throughout the season.

Initially, the club played in leagues based around Taunton and Tiverton. In the early 1960s, we gained promotion to the Somerset Senior League and succeeded in achieving Western League status in 1978 which has been retained ever since, making us one of the league's longest continuously serving members.

Since entering entered the Western League in the First Division, we have played at Premier Division level from 1981-82 to 1984-85 and 2008-09 to 2010-11. The team were then promoted as First Division champions at the end of the 2016-17 season and have since remained in the Premier Division.

In their first season back in the Premier Division, the team finished a creditable 15th and also reached the semi-finals of the Somerset Premier Cup. The side, who ended up 15<sup>th</sup> in 2022-23, are now managed by Richard Cherry, assisted by long-serving defender Jack Bown-Porter.

We have four other senior sides - the Reserves in the Devon and Exeter League's Division One, the A team in the Taunton Saturday League's Division One and the Ladies, who have two teams in the Somerset County Women's League.

We run 23 teams in our youth and minis with both boys and girls playing from the age of eight right through to 18 - along with coaching for even younger children. We also have a thriving Disability section with two adult sides and a youth team.

Off the pitch, Wellington AFC play a major role in the local community – we are home to a large number of skittles and darts teams and our social facilities are in use throughout the year for a wide range of events staged by local organisations, registered charities and individuals.

#### MATCH REPORT

#### Toolstation League premier division: Barnstaple Town 6, Wellington 0

Wellington's winning bubble was well and truly burst by undefeated Barnstaple Town in sunny North Devon last Saturday.

After successive victories for his side, manager Richard Cherry was without a number of key players for what was always going to be a tough game.

The absentees included loanees Josh Baker – their hat-trick hero in midweek – and Nathan Byrne who were both recalled by Willand Rovers.

Cherry opted to start with a 5-3-2 formation with defender Mark Cornish pushed up front and, although this soon switched to a more conventional 4-4-2, there was no stopping Barnstaple and in particular striker Oscar Massey, who bagged four goals on his home debut.

The Tangerines got off to the worst possible start, falling behind as the game entered only its second minute. A high ball into the box was knocked down and experienced striker Stuart Bowker drove low and powerfully into the net.

The hosts doubled their lead just before the half-hour as Massey – recently on the books of Swindon Town – got in behind to round keeper Rhys Williams before finishing coolly.

Wellington suffered another blow shortly afterwards as assistant player-manager Jack Bown-Porter limped off with a recurrence of a calf injury, and they went further behind before the break with Massey producing a stunning volley off the outside of his foot to give Williams to chance.

That left Wellington with a mountain to climb in the second half and – with diminutive home skipper Billy Tucker orchestrating most of the play – there was no way back.

Cherry, who had brought on his son Alex to replace Bown-Porter, also introduced Flynn Smith and Sol Barclay.

However, Barnstaple were equally as clinical in the second half, making it 4-0 on 68 minutes as sub Blake Shapland turned in a low cross.

But the star of the show was Massey, who swivelled to complete his hat-trick on 73 minutes, drove home his fourth with eight minutes remaining and chipped against the bar, after a brave save by Williams, in stoppage time.

#### TODAY'S VISITORS ILFRACOMBE TOWN

Ilfracombe Football Club was formed in November 1902 and played local opposition until the formation of the North Devon League in 1904, in which Combe became one of the founder members. The present name of Ilfracombe Town was adopted in 1920, the club contested the East Devon League remaining there for many years.

The present ground of Marlborough Park was acquired in 1923 and laid out for competitive football in the 1924/25 season. In 1949 Western League football was applied for and the club was admitted entry into division three for the season 1949/50, winning promotion as runners-up at the end of that year. During the 1952/53 season the club's finest FA Cup run was experienced by the only division two team to reach the fourth qualifying round where Llanelli was the venue and the result was 1-0 in favour of the Welshmen in front of an 8,500 gate.

Promotion to division one was also achieved at the end of the 52/53 season but, after two years, relegation was followed by poor results and poor support ultimately resulting in withdrawal from the league by the 1958/59 season.

During the 60s and 70s North Devon League football was again contested and during the early 80s, after some very encouraging seasons, it was decided to re-apply for Western League football and re-entry was accepted from the 1984/85 season.

On rejoining the Western League, the club contested division one for many seasons and promotion was eventually achieved to the premier division at the end of the 2006/07 season and Step 5 football was maintained with the winning of the Les Phillips Challenge Cup in the 2010/11 season. After 30 years of membership, the club decided to leave the Western League at the end of the 2012/13 season.

North Devon League football was once again contested with the first team in the premier division, the Reserves in the senior division and the third team in intermediate one. At the end of the 2016/17 season, all three teams won promotion and, with the Ladies team also achieving promotion, a very successful season was enjoyed.

The 2017/18 season saw Combe join the South West Peninsula East Division, and after a couple of good seasons the team was going very well when the season was curtailed because of COVID-19. They were moved up into the Western League premier division for the 2021/22 season when the non-league system was re-organised.

<u>Premier Division</u>: League leaders **Falmouth** were among a bunch of high-scoring home winners on Saturday afternoon, with a dominant second half leading them past **Street**. After being pegged back just prior to half-time, Falmouth flew out of the blocks after the interval, eventually winning by six goals to one. Sustained pressure from the hosts was finally rewarded two minutes before half-time when Harry Horton fired United into a one-goal lead. The Thorne's then took over the contest, with Dave making it 2-0 in the early stages of the second half, before Jack then struck twice to put the result beyond doubt. It was then left to recent addition Jay Murray to add the finishing touches, with his late volley capping an excellent five-goal performance.

**Barnstaple** went one better than Bridgy, scoring three times in either half to claim a 6-0 victory at home to **Wellington**. The visitors made the worst possible start, conceding inside the second minute when Stu Bowker stroked home. The in-form Oscar Massey then came to the fore for Town, with his quickfire double putting them three up at the break. Blake Shepherd was then on hand to fire home Barnstaple's fourth, before the unstoppable Massey took his personal tally to four with two further goals.

On a day of incredible goalscoring, **Brixham** went one better again, putting seven past a hapless **Millbrook** to secure their fourth consecutive league win, all without conceding. Their form man up top right now is Charlie Johansen, and after scoring at the beginning and end of the first half, the former Buckland frontman then struck again early in the second half to complete his hat-trick. There were four other scorers on Saturday

afternoon for the home side, with Cole Harford, Jake Chisholm, Jaden Maslen and Kieran Parkin condemning Millbrook to another tough loss.
