WELLINGTON AFC Club History

Formed in 1892, we are proud to be a three-star FA Accredited Club and run more than 30 teams, providing football for hundreds and men, women, boys and girls throughout the season.

Initially, the club played in leagues based around Taunton and Tiverton. In the early 1960s, we gained promotion to the Somerset Senior League and succeeded in achieving Western League status in 1978 which has been retained ever since, making us one of the league's longest continuously serving members.

Since entering entered the Western League in the First Division, we have played at Premier Division level from 1981-82 to 1984-85 and 2008-09 to 2010-11. The team were then promoted as First Division champions at the end of the 2016-17 season and have since remained in the Premier Division.

In their first season back in the Premier Division, the team finished a creditable 15th and also reached the semi-finals of the Somerset Premier Cup. The side, who ended up 15th in 2022-23, are now managed by Richard Cherry, assisted by long-serving defender Jack Bown-Porter.

We have four other senior sides - the Reserves in the Devon and Exeter League's Division One, the A team in the Taunton Saturday League's Division One and the Ladies, who have two teams in the Somerset County Women's League.

We run 23 teams in our youth and minis with both boys and girls playing from the age of eight right through to 18 - along with coaching for even younger children.

We also have a thriving Disability section with two adult sides and a youth team.

Off the pitch, Wellington AFC play a major role in the local community – we are home to a large number of skittles and darts teams and our social facilities are in use throughout the year for a wide range of events staged by local organisations, registered charities and individuals.

MATCH REPORT
LES PHILLIPS CUP – SECOND ROUND
WELLINGTON 2 3 ILFRACOMBE TOWN

Wellington bowed out of the Les Phillips Cup as they were undone by a second-half fightback from Ilfracombe Town at the Playing Field on Wednesday.

The Tangerines looked on course to end a run of three straight defeats when they led 2-0 after the break but the visitors from North Devon struck three times to earn a trip to Bridgwater United in the next round.

Manager Richard Cherry, who was without key players for the 5-0 defeat at Clevedon Town on Saturday, was able to field a stronger line-up including Josh Baker and Douglas Camilo, both jointly registered with Willand Rovers of the Southern League.

In the third meeting between the sides this season, the first half was entertaining with chances at both ends. Home skipper Tom Stone thumped a header against the bar while, at the other end, keeper Shay Allen produced a flying save to deny Tyler Evans-Loude.

But it was Wellington who broke the deadlock shortly before half-time when Baker crossed for Lewis Jennings to make no mistake from eight yards.

The Tangerines extended their lead only two minutes into the second half with an early contender for goal of the season. Camilo came out with the ball from a midfield melee and advanced on goal before letting fly from more than 30 yards, leaving keeper Laurence McCormick clutching at air as the ball flew into the top corner.

That was the signal for Ilfracombe to take the game to Wellington and they drew level after 55 minutes, Evans-Loude crossing for Jack Margarotto to slide the ball home.

The visitors had a 'goal' disallowed and Allen produced a stunning save to deny Gabriel Rogers but, shortly afterwards, they drew level with a cross from the right being bundled over the line by Evans-Loude.

Wellington were desperately unlucky not to regain the lead on 76 minutes when sub Flynn Smith saw a fierce drive smack against the upright.

However, five minutes later, Ilfracombe produced the winner and it was scored by Dan Wilson, their hat-trick hero in a 3-1 win at the Playing Field just over a week earlier.

The home defence failed to clear their lines and Wilson sent an unstoppable shot flying past Allen and into the top corner.

To complete Wellington's misery, they had young defender Ryan Hibbert sent off for a second yellow card with six minutes remaining.

TODAY'S VISITORS BRIXHAM

We extend a warm welcome to the players, officials and supporters from Brixham for this afternoons Toolstation Western League Premier Division game.

The club was formed in 2012 when Brixham United and Brixham Villa merged in the South Devon League. Brixham Villa had been a club since 1953 and had previously won the league in 2007, while Brixham United had previously competed in the Western League between 1976 and 1981.

After finishing runners-up in the South Devon League, the club were promoted to the South West Peninsula League Division One East in 2014. The League was restructured in 2019 and Brixham were promoted to the Premier Division East, having finished in third place the previous season.


Floodlights were installed and the first home match under the new lights was on 10 September 2019, a 2-1 win over Bovey Tracey.

The club narrowly missed out on promotion on a points-per-game basis over the next two Covid-affected seasons and having finished runners-up to Torpoint Athletic in 2022, they won the championship last season and thus promotion to the Western League Premier Division.

Last season also saw the club's best ever run in the FA Vase, defeating two higher-level clubs before going out on penalties at Corsham Town in the Fifth Round Proper.

The club's ground - now known as The More Seafood Ground - was previously the home of Brixham United.

Brixham AFC is a FA Charter Standard club affiliated to the Devon County FA.

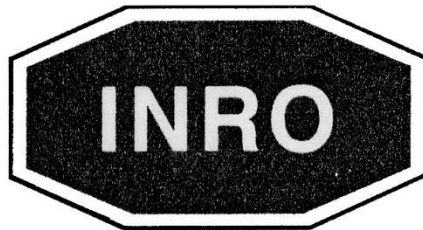

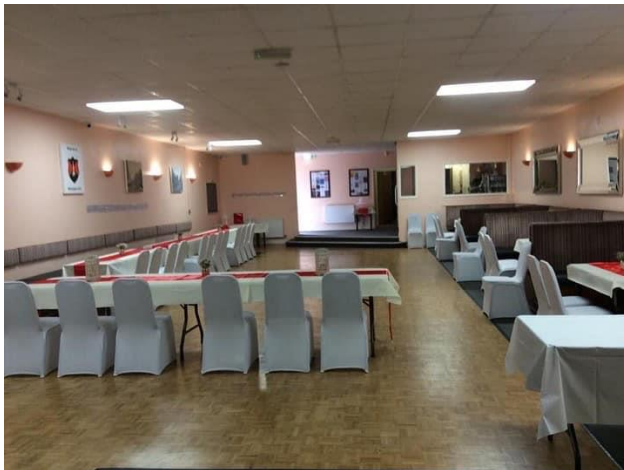
