

WELLINGTON AFC Club History

Formed in 1892, we are proud to be a three-star FA Accredited Club and run more than 30 teams, providing football for hundreds and men, women, boys and girls throughout the season.

Initially, the club played in leagues based around Taunton and Tiverton. In the early 1960s, we gained promotion to the Somerset Senior League and succeeded in achieving Western League status in 1978 which has been retained ever since, making us one of the league's longest continuously serving members.

Since entering entered the Western League in the First Division, we have played at Premier Division level from 1981-82 to 1984-85 and 2008-09 to 2010-11. The team were then promoted as First Division champions at the end of the 2016-17 season and have since remained in the Premier Division.

In their first season back in the Premier Division, the team finished a creditable 15th and also reached the semi-finals of the Somerset Premier Cup. The side, who ended up 15th in 2022-23, are now managed by Richard Cherry, assisted by long-serving defender Jack Bown-Porter.

We have four other senior sides - the Reserves in the Devon and Exeter League's Division One, the A team in the Taunton Saturday League's Division One and the Ladies, who have two teams in the Somerset County Women's League.

We run 23 teams in our youth and minis with both boys and girls playing from the age of eight right through to 18 - along with coaching for even younger children.

We also have a thriving Disability section with two adult sides and a youth team.

Off the pitch, Wellington AFC play a major role in the local community – we are home to a large number of skittles and darts teams and our social facilities are in use throughout the year for a wide range of events staged by local organisations, registered charities and individuals.

MATCH REPORT WELLINGTON 1 2 BRIDGWATER UNITED

Wellington pushed promotion chasing Bridgwater United all the way before going down to an odd-goal defeat in front of a bumper Boxing Day crowd at the Playing Field.

After a disappointing start to the season, Richard Cherry's side have shown a marked improvement in recent weeks. And that continued with a wholehearted display which saw the visitors clinging on for the points in the closing stages.

Although they were without midfielder Glen Wright, the Tangerines' line up included Sam Towler, who rejoined the club recently from Bridgwater, and Jamie Nicholson, back home from Canada for Christmas and New Year.

The game started at a frantic pace and Wellington took a shock lead after only ten minutes when a low cross by Lewis Jennings found Sully McKenna completely unmarked to sidefoot home from eight yards.

Bridgwater, now managed by ex-Bristol City defender Andy Llewellyn, drew level nine minutes later as the hosts failed in a number of attempts to clear their lines and the ball broke to Jay Murray, who poked it past keeper Shay Allen.

The visitors then went ahead four minutes into the second half, although Wellington felt they should have been awarded a free kick as Ryan Brereton was bundled over before the ball was played forward to Murray who advanced and clinically doubled his tally.

That was the signal for the Tangerines take the game to Bridgwater and they launched wave after wave of attack without being able to make the breakthrough – even when their former defender Dave Thorne was sin binned for ten minutes.

They came so close to an equaliser in stoppage time as a goalbound shot from substitute Jordan Hayman smacked against a defender on the line before being cleared.

Despite the result, Wellington could hold their heads high at the final whistle.



TODAY'S VISITORS NAILSEA & TICKENHAM

We extend a warm welcome to the players, officials and supporters of Nailsea & Tickenham for today's Toolstation League Premier Division game.

At the end of the 2014/15 Football season a meeting took place between officials from Nailsea Town and Tickenham United Football Club. From this meeting it was agreed that the pooling of resources would present an opportunity to become the first club in Nailsea's history to offer Western League Football. Nailsea and Tickenham FC was born.

The previous nicknames of Nailsea Town and Tickenham Utd were the Swans and the Stags and a new nickname "The SWAGS" was created!

Since the merger, the club has finished in the top three of the Somerset County Premier Division, twice as Runners Up, also winning the Somerset County Cup on two occasions and Runners up in the Premier/First Division Cup Final. Our reserves are currently playing in the Somerset County League Division 1.

During this time the club has continued to make improvements to the ground at Fryth Way and acquired some portacabins from Bristol City's old training ground, which gave us the opportunity to open a new small clubhouse and bar, a new public toilet block, kitchen and club officials room.

In season 2021/22, the dream became a reality and our first team won the Somerset County Premier Division. This was a very special season as the team never lost a game, playing 30. Winning 25 and drawing just 5. In addition to this, they also won the Premier and 1st Division cup, presenting the club with the double by defeating Chilcompton 4-2 in the final.

Our first season of Western League football, which we knew would be a huge challenge was nothing less than amazing and saw us gain back-to-back promotions, finishing Runners up in Division One and holding a top three spot for most of the season.

The Premier Division is once again unknown territory for the club and we know it will present many challenges, and we will continue to face these head on and enjoy the journey.



EXTRACT FROM TOOLSTATION BULLETIN 31st December 2023



On a wet and windy end to 2023, **Clevedon** finished top of the pile in the Western League thanks to their dramatic 1-0 win away at **Bridgwater**. The Seasiders have suffered just one defeat this season, and toppled third-place Bridgwater thanks to a late winner from leading scorer Sam Beresford. With the game in the sixth minute of added time, Beresford reacted quickest to a loose ball in the box after teammate Elliot Nicholson had seen his shot come back off the crossbar.

Breathing down Clevedon's neck are **Helston Athletic** who rebounded from their Boxing Day defeat with a 4-0 defeat of **Torpoint**. In another Cornish Christmas derby, Helston came out with a point to prove in the first half, with Sam Carter firing them ahead in the 20th minute. Carter then turned provider, crossing for Jordan Bentley who doubled their advantage, with Bentley then adding his sides third ten minutes before the interval. 
