WELLINGTON AFC Club History

Formed in 1892, we are proud to be a three-star FA Accredited Club and run more than 30 teams, providing football for hundreds and men, women, boys and girls throughout the season.

Initially, the club played in leagues based around Taunton and Tiverton. In the early 1960s, we gained promotion to the Somerset Senior League and succeeded in achieving Western League status in 1978 which has been retained ever since, making us one of the league's longest continuously serving members.

Since entering entered the Western League in the First Division, we have played at Premier Division level from 1981-82 to 1984-85 and 2008-09 to 2010-11. The team were then promoted as First Division champions at the end of the 2016-17 season and have since remained in the Premier Division.

In their first season back in the Premier Division, the team finished a creditable 15th and also reached the semi-finals of the Somerset Premier Cup. The side, who ended up 15th in 2022-23, are now managed by Richard Cherry, assisted by long-serving defender Jack Bown-Porter.

We have four other senior sides - the Reserves in the Devon and Exeter League's Division One, the A team in the Taunton Saturday League's Division One and the Ladies, who have two teams in the Somerset County Women's League.

We run 23 teams in our youth and minis with both boys and girls playing from the age of eight right through to 18 - along with coaching for even younger children.

We also have a thriving Disability section with two adult sides and a youth team.

Off the pitch, Wellington AFC play a major role in the local community – we are home to a large number of skittles and darts teams and our social facilities are in use throughout the year for a wide range of events staged by local organisations, registered charities and individuals.

MATCH REPORT SOMERSET PREMIER CUP – QUARTER-FINAL LARKHALL ATHLETIC 1 0 WELLINGTON

A goal right at the death saw battling Wellington bow out of the Somerset Premier Cup at the quarter-finals stage in Bath on Wednesday (March 13th).

Despite being without a host of first team regulars, the Tangerines worked their socks off against Larkhall who play at a level above them in the South Division of the Southern League.

They were within three minutes of a penalty shootout when the hosts' late winner foiled their hopes of landing a home semi-final against Taunton Town.

Wellington's absentees included keeper Jake Viney, midfielder Sam Towler and winger Sully McKenna – all cup tied – while a number of others were unavailable for the rearranged tie.

The line-up included teenage keeper Charlie Hawkings, Danny Wordsworth making his first start and Connor Noble, their only sub, who came on after 32 minutes for the injured Gabriel Plant to make his first team debut.

Wellington played up the slope in the first half and defended magnificently with Larkhall's only clearcut chance, in the 38th minute, seeing Matthew Bowman head wide.

It was a similar story after the break with the hosts repeatedly frustrated in their efforts to break the deadlock.

Wellington had an opening of their own on the hour when Glen Wright's header was well saved by keeper Arthur Nasta.

They then came agonisingly close to taking a shock lead with nine minutes remaining as Ryan Brereton's long range volley smacked against the bar with Nasta beaten.

While Larkhall introduced fresh legs from the bench, Wellington were unable to do the same and, in the closing stages, a number of players were struggling with either injuries or cramp as the heavy pitch took its toll.

However, just as it looked like they might hold out, their resistance was finally broken after 87 minutes.

The ball was played inside to Harvey Pritchard, Larkhall's best player, and he skipped past a defender before drilling home the winner from 12 yards.

Although left disappointed by the result, the Tangerines can take heart from a gutsy performance ahead of their important Toolstation League game against Millbrook this afternoon.

TODAY'S VISITORS MILLBROOK

We extend a warm welcome to the players, officials and supporters of Millbrook for today's Toolstation League Premier Division game.

Millbrook Association Football Club is a football club based in Millbrook, Cornwall. They are currently members of the Western League Premier Division and play at Jenkins Park.

The club was established in 1888. They played in district leagues, including the Plymouth and district league, where they hold a record in history of the only Cornish team to win the Devon Senior Cup which was in 1914.

For over 90 years we played in the P&D leagues until joining the South Western League in 1980. The club were South Western League runners-up in 1981–82 and finished in the top five every season until 1988–89, also reaching the final of the Cornwall senior cup in 1983/84. After losing another Cornwall Senior Cup final in 1998/99, they entered the FA Vase for the first time in 2004/05, losing 2–1 at home to Exmouth Town.

The club remained in the league until it merged with the Devon County League to form the South west peninsula league in 2007, at which point they were placed in Division One West. After finishing bottom of Division One West in 2008/09 and second-from-bottom in 2009/10, financial problems forced Millbrook to resign from the league, with the first team taking over from the reserves in Division One of the East Cornwall League. The club were Division One runners-up in 2012/13, earning promotion to the Premier Division. A third-place finish in the Premier Division in 2013–14, a season that also saw them lose the League Cup final, was enough to secure promotion back to Division One West of the South West Peninsula League.

In 2017/18 Millbrook were crowned Division One West champions, earning promotion to the Premier Division. Following league reorganisation at the end of the 2018/19 season, the club were placed in the Premier Division East. In 2021 they were promoted to the Premier Division of the Toolstation

Western league based on their results in the abandoned 2019/20 and 2020/21 seasons.

To date the club are standing firm in the Western Premier Division. Another hard fought season was had in 2022/23 which saw challenges on and off the field. A great cup run saw them reach the final of the Cornwall Senior Cup, narrowly loosing out on penalties to Helston Athletic at Blaze Park.

The club play at Jenkins Park on Mill Road. The ground was originally named Mill Park, but was renamed in 2014 after former professional footballer Reg Jenkins, who was born in the village and went on to become Rochdale's record goalscorer. After retiring he returned to Cornwall and helped run the football Club.

Premier Division: Helston overcame a tough trip to Street, prevailing by three goals to nil to maintain their slender lead atop the league table. A tight opening half saw the game remain goalless for 43 minutes, until the away side were awarded a penalty which was duly converted by Jordan Copp. Helston then added to their advantage early in the second period through Tom Payne, before Copp struck again in the closing stages to complete the victory.

Goals in either half from Freddie King proved pivotal for the hosts, with Harley Vozza also getting on the scoresheet with a smart finish during the final ten minutes.

Another player to score twice on Saturday afternoon was **Buckland**'s Jared Lewington, with the division's leading marksman helping fire his side to a 3-1 win over **Nailsea & Tickenham.** A close range strike from Lewington got the ball rolling for the Bucks early on, with Josh Grant then making it 2-0 inside 15 minutes. Lewington managed to strike again at the end of the first half to all-but end the contest, with Nailsea's Luke Osgood reducing the deficit slightly after the interval.

3-1 was a very popular scoreline all afternoon, with both **Shepton Mallet** and **Brixham** grabbing victories by the same margin. For Brixham, three goals in the space of ten second half minutes from Scott Robinson, Tom Mortimore and Charlie Johansen did all the damage in their away win over **Oldland Abbotonians**.

In Somerset, Shepton followed up their Les Phillips semi-final triumph with another impressive home victory over **St Blazey**. First half efforts from Charlie Bateson and Joel Sisson put Mallet in position to push for

victory, with Paul Braithwaite extending the lead out further prior to a late consolation for the Cornish outfit courtesy of George Newton. **Bridgwater** were the afternoon's other winners, with goals either side of the interval from Ben Griffith and Jack Taylor helping them defeat **Welton** by two goals to nil.

Elsewhere, **Falmouth's** epic run in the **FA Vase** was ended in Essex, with a pair of second half goals from Harry Talbot leading **Great Wakering Rovers** to a 2-0 win.
