WELLINGTON AFC Club History

Formed in 1892, we are proud to be a three-star FA Accredited Club and run more than 30 teams, providing football for hundreds and men, women, boys and girls throughout the season.

Initially, the club played in leagues based around Taunton and Tiverton. In the early 1960s, we gained promotion to the Somerset Senior League and succeeded in achieving Western League status in 1978 which has been retained ever since, making us one of the league's longest continuously serving members.

Since entering entered the Western League in the First Division, we have played at Premier Division level from 1981-82 to 1984-85 and 2008-09 to 2010-11. The team were then promoted as First Division champions at the end of the 2016-17 season and have since remained in the Premier Division.

In their first season back in the Premier Division, the team finished a creditable 15th and also reached the semi-finals of the Somerset Premier Cup. The side, who ended up 15th in 2022-23, are now managed by Richard Cherry, assisted by long-serving defender Jack Bown-Porter.

We have four other senior sides - the Reserves in the Devon and Exeter League's Division One, the A team in the Taunton Saturday League's Division One and the Ladies, who have two teams in the Somerset County Women's League.

We run 23 teams in our youth and minis with both boys and girls playing from the age of eight right through to 18 - along with coaching for even younger children.

We also have a thriving Disability section with two adult sides and a youth team.

Off the pitch, Wellington AFC play a major role in the local community – we are home to a large number of skittles and darts teams and our social facilities are in use throughout the year for a wide range of events staged by local organisations, registered charities and individuals.



MATCH REPORT

WELLINGTON 1 2 SALTASH UNITED

Wellington bid for a third successive premier division victory was thwarted by Saltash United at the Playing Field last Tuesday (March 26th).

Both sides have shown a marked improvement in recent weeks, having struggled in the lower reaches of the table, and it was a close game. But Saltash were slightly the better side and the three points they took back to Cornwall enabled them to leapfrog the Tangerines into 14th place.

Manager Richard Cherry rang the changes after Saturday's win 2-1 over Oldland Abbotonians including a surprise return for striker Jordan Casey and midfielder Harry Walford – signed on dual registration with Alphington of the Devon and Exeter League. His starting 11 also included young defender Harry Scott, signed on a dual registration with Bishops Lydeard.

The Tangerines got off to an excellent start by taking the lead after only eight minutes. A long free kick was headed down by Kieran Bailey to Casey and, when he was brought down, the referee pointed to the spot. Sam Towler stepped up to coolly slot home his second successive penalty, having scored the late winner against Oldland.

But the Wellington joy was short lived as Saltash equalised within five minutes. The ball was played over the top to their pacey No11 Joe Preece, and he drilled a low shot past keeper Jake Viney.

Both sides created half-chances as an entertaining first half ended all-square.

However, it was the visitors who went ahead seven minutes after the break with another quick seeing Viney save well but Preece gratefully tucked home the rebound.

Wellington huffed and puffed to get back on terms although it was the visitors who always looked more dangerous with man-of-the-match Viney pulling off a couple of excellent saves.



TODAY'S VISITORS STREET

We extend a warm welcome to the players, officials and supporters of Street for today's Toolstation League Premier Division game.

Founded in 1880, **Street Football Club** is one of the oldest Association Football clubs in Somerset and were given the nickname 'The Cobblers' due to the large shoemaking industry in the village and surrounding area.

Playing at county level for the first quarter of its history, the Club won the Somerset Senior League 5 times and the Somerset FA Senior Cup 3 times before making its first foray into the Western League a few seasons before the onset of World War One.

For the remainder of the 20th century Street FC yo-yoed between the Western League and the Somerset Senior League winning a few honours along the way.

The Club also had its best FA Cup runs during this period by reaching the First Round Proper twice, once either side of World War Two; in 1938 away to Ipswich Town and 1947 at Cheltenham Town - after beating Yeovil Town 2-1 in front of a record 5,000 crowd at The Victoria Field in the previous round.

The closest the Club came to winning the Western League Championship during the 20th century was in season 1952-53 when they were pipped to the title by Barnstaple Town, who had a 0.01 better goal average after the sides had finished level on 44 points each. However, leaner times returned and the Club soon found itself back at county level once more.

Season 1996-97 saw the Club win the Somerset Senior League for a record eighth time, thus gaining promotion back to the Western League after a 37-year absence. Ten years later, after gaining promotion to the Premier Division in season 2005-06, the Club had its best run in The FA Vase when reaching the Fifth Round Proper before losing at Wimborne Town.

After finishing as Premier Division Runners-up the previous season, the 2017-18 campaign was the Club's 50th in the Western League, and was a momentous one too! Early results were inconsistent: but starting on 12th September, manager Richard Fey's charges completed a sensational run of **26 consecutive league victories** that eventually saw the team win the title by 15 points (falling just one point short of the century) after winning 32 of their 38 games and scoring 100 goals, thus earning a place in the Southern Football League for the first time in the Club's 138-year history.

However, 2018-19 was to be the only season at the higher level for the Club as it soon became clear that Southern League football was a 'step too far': and despite a respectable seventh-place finish, the decision was taken to protect the long-term future of the Club and return to the Toolstation Western League.

Since the beginning of season 2019-20 the Club has changed its emphasis and opted to recruit a management team and playing squad that focusses more on youth and local player development and progression.




