WELLINGTON AFC Club History

Formed in 1892, we are proud to be a three-star FA Accredited Club and run more than 30 teams, providing football for hundreds and men, women, boys and girls throughout the season.

Initially, the club played in leagues based around Taunton and Tiverton. In the early 1960s, we gained promotion to the Somerset Senior League and succeeded in achieving Western League status in 1978 which has been retained ever since, making us one of the league's longest continuously serving members.

Since entering entered the Western League in the First Division, we have played at Premier Division level from 1981-82 to 1984-85 and 2008-09 to 2010-11. The team were then promoted as First Division champions at the end of the 2016-17 season and have since remained in the Premier Division.

In their first season back in the Premier Division, the team finished a creditable 15th and also reached the semi-finals of the Somerset Premier Cup. The side, who ended up 15th in 2022-23, are now managed by Richard Cherry, assisted by long-serving defender Jack Bown-Porter.

We have four other senior sides - the Reserves in the Devon and Exeter League's Division One, the A team in the Taunton Saturday League's Division One and the Ladies, who have two teams in the Somerset County Women's League.

We run 23 teams in our youth and minis with both boys and girls playing from the age of seven right through to 18 - along with coaching for even younger children.

We also have a thriving Disability section with two adult sides and a youth teams.

Off the pitch, Wellington AFC play a major role in the local community – we are home to a large number of skittles and darts teams and our social facilities are in use throughout the year for a wide range of events staged by local organisations, registered charities and individuals.

MATCH REPORT WELLINGTON 2 0 STREET

Wellington took another step towards securing their premier division future as two late goals sank Street at a soggy Playing Field on Easter Monday (April 1st).

The result lifted the Tangerines up into 14th place - 17 points ahead of bottom club Millbrook with only one team being relegated this season. It also saw them bounce back from previous week's home defeat by Saltash United, the team they have leapfrogged in the table.

Although the pitch passed a morning inspection, heavy rain ahead of kickoff and during the first half made conditions extremely difficult. But, to their credit, both sides produced an entertaining spectacle.

Wellington started brightly while Street looked dangerous as they moved the ball forward quickly with home keeper Jake Viney producing a couple of smart saves to ensure it stayed goalless at half-time.

The Tangerines suffered a blow ten minutes after the break when skipper Tom Stone limped off with an injury sustained earlier in the game. That brought a welcome return for young central defender Jordan Hayman after a long injury lay-off while further substitutions by manager Richard Cherry turned the match in Wellington's favour. They introduced more width into their play, resulting in both goals to clinch victory.

With 12 minutes remaining, Sam Towler played the ball out to sub Sully McKenna whose long cross was met at full stretch by Josh Lukins and his looping header dropped inside the opposite post.

Street went close to an equaliser before the hosts sealed the points in injury time.

Another sub, Rohan Poulsom, intercepted a loose pass out wide, advanced on goal and, from his pinpoint cross, Towler produced a sublime low finish past former Wellington keeper Shay Allen.

TODAY'S VISITORS FALMOUTH TOWN

We extend a warm welcome to the players, officials and supporters of Falmouth Town for today's Toolstation League Premier Division game.

Falmouth Town joined the old Cornwall Senior League in 1950 before becoming founder members of the South Western League in 1951/52. After several homes, the sale of their Ashfield ground to Shell-Mex BP enabled the purchase of their present home at Bickland Park.

By the late 1950's, professionalism was introduced and this led to Falmouth winning their first trophy, the SWL Cup, in the 1957/58 season and retained it the following season. Season 1961/62 saw Falmouth Town win the treble of League Championship, League Cup and Cornwall Senior Cup.

The following season history was made when they became the first ever Cornish club to the reach the First Round Proper of the FA Cup where they lost by two goals to one at home to Oxford United whose team included Ron Atkinson, in front of a crowd of 8000. Town reached the First Round on two more occasions in 1967 and 1969 losing both times to Peterborough United, first 5-2 away and then 1-4 at home.

After much more domestic success and winning the South Western League for four consecutive years, Town joined the Western League in season 1974/75. They won both the League and League Cup in their first season without losing a single game and then won the League Championship in the following three seasons. Whilst in the Western League, Falmouth won the Cornwall Senior Cup in four successive seasons, from 1975/76 to 1978/79.

In 1975, midfielder Roy Carter left to join Hereford United in the Football League, going on to play for Swindon Town, Torquay United, Bristol Rovers and Newport County. The following year Town's ace goal scorer Tony Kellow was sold to Exeter City for a record transfer fee of £12,000 and remains their all-time top goal scorer. Then, in 1978 club record scorer Joe Scott joined Bournemouth.

After nine seasons, increased travelling expenses forced Falmouth to resign from the Western League and not being accepted back into the South Western League,

had to enter the Cornwall Combination League which they won at the first attempt.

Back in the South Western League they became champions again in 1985/86 which was won several more times along with numerous cups. A period of turmoil then followed with ups and downs in the clubs fortunes both on and off the pitch.

With the formation of the South West Peninsula League, Falmouth Town plied their trade in the Premier Division but never achieved any success until the appointment of local lad and player, Andrew Westgarth. Being his first appointment as manager of any club, he had a steep learning curve. The pendulum eventually started to swing in the right direction and after a period of steady progress Westgarth lead the club to its first success in many years when in season 2017/18 the club won the South West Peninsula League Cup and the League Charity Bowl.

Next season the Cornwall Senior Cup was won and following two incomplete seasons due to the Covid Pandemic, in the first full season after the FA instigated a revised pyramid system, Falmouth Town won the league championship for the first time and with it promotion to the Western League. To complete a fantastic season, the Cornwall Senior Cup and League Charity Bowl were also won to complete a magnificent treble.
