WELLINGTON AFC Club History

Formed in 1892, we are proud to be a three-star FA Accredited Club and run more than 30 teams, providing football for hundreds of men, women, boys and girls throughout the season.

Initially, the club played in leagues based around Taunton and Tiverton. In the early 1960s, we gained promotion to the Somerset Senior League and succeeded in achieving Western League status in 1978 which has been retained ever since, making us one of the league's longest continuously serving members.

Since entering the Western League in the First Division, we have played at Premier Division level from 1981-82 to 1984-85 and 2008-09 to 2010-11. The team were then promoted as First Division champions at the end of the 2016-17 season and have since remained in the Premier Division.

In their first season back, the team finished a creditable 15th and also reached the semi-finals of the Somerset Premier Cup.

The side, who finished 15th in 2023-24, are now managed by Richard Cherry.

We have four other senior sides - the Reserves in the Devon and Exeter League's premier division, the A team in the Taunton Saturday League's premier division and the Ladies, who have two teams in the Somerset County Women's League.

We run 23 teams in our youth and minis with both boys and girls playing from the age of seven right through to 18 - along with coaching for even younger children.

We also have a thriving Disability section with two adult sides and two youth teams.

Off the pitch, Wellington AFC play a major role in the local community – we are home to a large number of skittles and darts teams and our social facilities are in use throughout the year for a wide range of events staged by local organisations, registered charities and individuals.

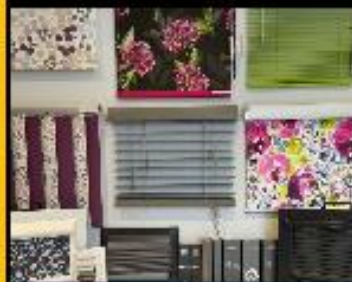

MATCH REPORT
Les Phillips Cup – First Round

Wellington made it four wins on the trot as they progressed in the Jewson Western League's Les Phillips Cup in Dorset on Tuesday evening.

With his injury crisis easing, manager Richard Cherry's line-up for the tie included returns for experienced keeper Jake Viney and midfielder Sam Pashen.

Gillingham play in the division below Wellington and are currently propping up the table and, although the Tangerines coasted into a three-goal lead, they were given a few scares after the break.

The visitors got off to a flying start with a goal after only three minutes as Nathan Byrne cut in from the left to produce a cool finish.

Gillingham had a couple of early efforts on goal but Wellington were dominant in the first half and added a second after 42 minutes when Pashen's shot was blocked by the keeper and he followed up to drive home the rebound.

It was a similar story after the break with the Tangerines extending their lead from another rebound on the hour mark. This time, Charlie Wilson's effort came back to Jake Mawford, who made no mistake.

That was the signal for Gillingham to up their game and they were unfortunate not to make inroads on the deficit, hitting the post and forcing a couple of smart saves from Viney.

Cherry will have been pleased with both the result and the clean sheet ahead of today's return to league action when they host Oldland Abbotonians.

TODAY'S VISITORS OLDLAND ABBOTONIANS

Bristol and District League handbooks of the 1920's revealed that the Oldland football club was founded as St. Anne's (Oldland) in 1910. Little is known about the club's fortunes between the wars but they became founder members of the Bristol Premier Combination in 1962 and were promoted to the Gloucester County League in 1973, remaining there for twelve seasons until being re-elected as Oldland Decora in 1986.

Pupils at Hanham Abbots school launched Abbotonians football club as juniors in 1947 and they enjoyed many league and cup successes in the early years, including Cup wins in 1961, 1966 and 1972. The two clubs merged in 1998, playing as Oldland Abbotonians in the Somerset Senior League. Oldland Abbotonians won the Somerset Senior League Division One in 2004/05, were Premier Division runners up in 2005/06 and eventually promoted to the Toolstation League in 2006/07.

Oldland has often been described as a nursery for Bristol Rovers with Vic Lambden, Peter Sampson, Brian Bush and Mike Tippets all playing for the club before turning professional at Eastville. Former Rovers favourite Bobby Jones was one of many successful Oldland managers, a list which also includes David Hillier. Abbots rose to heady heights under the leadership of Alan Bush in the 1980's with the help of former Rovers players Jeff Meacham, the late Steve Talboys (Wimbledon) plus Rovers favourites Graham Day, Peter Aitken and Phil Bater. Among other youngsters who left Abbots to play for Rovers were Stuart Taylor, Phil Kite and Kevin Westaway.

Former Bristol Rovers player David Hillier helped manage The Ost to become the first ever Division 1 side to win the Les Phillips Cup. Having finished 4th and been assured that promotion was imminent at the end of 2015/16 Oldland were disappointingly not promoted and had to start again with the squad moving away. 2016/17 was a pivotal year as

although the football side disappointed, through fundraising and grants the club spent in excess of £70,000 on ground improvements including safety fencing, stand covers, pitch maintenance equipment, a new stand and CCTV system and in the past few years the ground has been fully enclosed with new dressing rooms added and the bar extended as chairman Clayton Woodman has grown the club massively off the pitch.

In 2017/18 Clayton Woodman and Steve Cains returned to the club they had played for before stepping aside to bring in Paul Weeks as Director of Football, the first team manager is Craig Laird with years of experience at the likes of Weston, Dorchester and Yate assisted by Darren Sealey and Nic Mann. Being promoted through the play offs into the Toolstation Western League Premier Division and a welcome return to the FA Cup for the club from 2023/24 onwards saw Oldland very much looking to the future.

The Reserves are in the Bristol Premier Combination and are managed by Steve Cains, Craig Durnell and from 2018/19 a 3rd team play in the Bristol & District League, managed by Mitchell Jones and Dave Griffin. In addition to this, there is an Under 18s side managed by Griffin who play in the Western Counties Floodlit League.

The clubhouse and dressing room improvements are planned with the ground boundaries and exterior being upgraded in 2022/23 and the bar is known by many as the liveliest, friendliest and best clubhouse in the league with numerous social events in addition to match days.

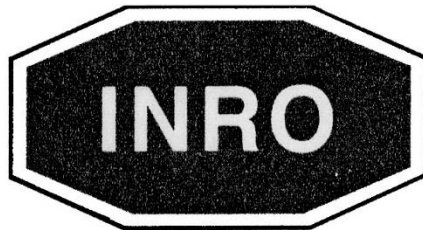

- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee and match officials
- Never engage in or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language
- Never engage in threatening or violent behaviour
- Stay behind the touchline and within the designated spectator's area

You must fully understand and readily accept that failure to comply with any of the above may result in you being:

- Issued with a verbal warning from a club or league official
- Obligated to leave the match venue by the club
- Required to meet with the club committee, league or Welfare Officer
- Obligated to undertake an FA education course
- Requested not to attend future games, be suspended or have your membership removed

In addition:

- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and/or suspension on the club
- Any physical assault on a Match Official will result in a lengthy or permanent exclusion from football and possibly a criminal prosecution
