## WELLINGTON AFC Club History

Formed in 1892, we are proud to be a three-star FA Accredited Club and run more than 30 teams, providing football for hundreds of men, women, boys and girls throughout the season.

Initially, the club played in leagues based around Taunton and Tiverton. In the early 1960s, we gained promotion to the Somerset Senior League and succeeded in achieving Western League status in 1978 which has been retained ever since, making us one of the league's longest continuously serving members.

Since entering the Western League in the First Division, we have played at Premier Division level from 1981-82 to 1984-85 and 2008-09 to 2010-11. The team were then promoted as First Division champions at the end of the 2016-17 season and have since remained in the Premier Division.

In their first season back, the team finished a creditable 15th and also reached the semi-finals of the Somerset Premier Cup.

The side, who finished 15th in 2023-24, are now managed by Richard Cherry.

We have four other senior sides - the Reserves in the Devon and Exeter League's premier division, the A team in the Taunton Saturday League's premier division and the Ladies, who have two teams in the Somerset County Women's League.

We run 23 teams in our youth and minis with both boys and girls playing from the age of seven right through to 18 - along with coaching for even younger children.

We also have a thriving Disability section with two adult sides and two youth teams.

Off the pitch, Wellington AFC play a major role in the local community – we are home to a large number of skittles and darts teams and our social facilities are in use throughout the year for a wide range of events staged by local organisations, registered charities and individuals.

After successive away wins, Wellington went down to a disappointing defeat by Brixham at the Playing Field on Wednesday evening.

Manager Richard Cherry was again missing a string of players through injury plus talented defender Harry Scott who has moved to premier rivals Barnstaple Town.

His line-up included a return for Harry Walford and a debut for evergreen striker Jake Mawford – signed from Street – while the subs included former joint manager Tim Legg.

Mawford was in the thick of the action early on as he went down in the box but, instead of winning a penalty, he was booked for diving.

Brixham then went straight up the other end and took the lead with a goal credited to James Moxon although the final touch looked to have come off a Wellington player.

The Tangerines almost drew level after 26 minutes but Jake Quick shot straight at the keeper from a good position.

And the visitors then increased their lead against the run of play on the half-hour with a clinical finish by Charlie Johansen.

Things got worse for the hosts with two more goals either side of half-time, scored by Jaden Maslen and Moxon.

That sealed a revenge victory for Brixham who lost 2-1 when the sides met in Devon back in August.

## TODAY'S VISITORS PAULTON ROVERS

Paulton Rovers was formed in 1890 by the village's vicar and a local businessman. The club joined the Western League in 1900 with their best position being runners up in the 2003/4 season, when they secured promotion to the Southern League. The club has won the Somerset Senior Cup on twelve occasions, and the Somerset Senior League seven times. The club last won the Somerset Senior Cup in 1974, when they were re-admitted to the Western League after an absence of fourteen years.

Paulton Rovers best attendance of 2,070 (deemed maximum capacity) was on 7th November 2009 reaching the FA Cup 1st Round for the first time. The match against Norwich City, was broadcast live on ITV1 and to over 30 other countries. The largest crowd prior to that, estimated at over 2,000 saw Rovers take on Crewe Alexandra in the FA Cup 5th Qualifying Round in 1906.

After playing at several venues in the village, Rovers moved to Winterfield Road in 1954. In 1967, an old RAF hut served as the club house with a licenced bar. Soon plans were drawn up to build bigger premises including a skittle alley. The pitch was turned 90 degrees, so the club house is built on one of the former penalty areas. The social club is now the premier venue for many social occasions within the rapidly expanding local community.

In 1972 a new changing room block was built behind the main stand and the club was further extended. On promotion to the Southern League the premises and stadium were improved with the addition of another stand, covered terracing and training facilities that included an all-weather floodlit court. It was under the management team of Darren Perrin and Mike Kilgour that Rovers secured promotion to the Southern League in 2004. Rovers finished just outside the play-offs in the following season and Darren left for Premier Division, Chippenham Town.

In July 2005 Andy Jones stepped up from Reserve Manager. In 2006/7 the club finished runners up in Division One South & West and narrowly missed out on the play-offs the following year. His successful 5-year tenure was highlighted by reaching the 1st round of the FA Cup. In 2010, Andy Jones moved on and former club captain, Mark Harrington took charge. Harrington stood down after just one season to be replaced by former player, Nick Bunyard. Paul Milsom assisted

all three managers during this time and the season ended with Rovers winning the Somerset Premier Cup for the first time with a 3-1 win over Bridgwater Town.

In 2013/14, after losing out in the play-offs the previous year, Rovers finished in fourth place and defeated Tiverton Town 3-1 in the semi-final when they were down to 9 men. "Bunny's" men then defied the odds to win the play-off Final at Merthyr Town in front of a crowd of 2,201 and thus gain promotion to Step 3 for the first time in their history.

In the 2014/15 season Rovers finished a more creditable 10th place in the Premier Division. During the close season, Bunyard resigned for personal reasons and the club appointed Richard Fey from Bridgwater Town as manager. After a disappointing start Fey resigned and former Bath City boss Tony Ricketts took charge at the end of October.


Unfortunately, the club finished bottom and relegated back to Division 1 South and West. Despite providing a period of stability Ricketts left at the end of 2016/17 and former Rovers keeper John Rendell was appointed manager bringing former players Gary Powell and Paul Tovey as his assistants. John Rendell and his assistants, including Physio and kit-man left in November 2022 to join Yate Town who were relegated at the end of last season and join Rovers in Division 1 South.

Craig Loxton and John Durban were appointed Managers within a week of Rendell's departure and kept Rovers in the Division and worked very hard in building a new squad. They resigned in October 2023 following a disappointing run of results and were replaced by Kyle Tooze in a Player/Manager role.

After a short, disappointing period in charge, the club and Kyle departed ways, with previous manager Richard Fey coming in to try and keep Paulton's survival hopes alive. Despite their best efforts, unfortunately Paulton Rovers finished the season 2nd from bottom and were relegated into the Western Premier Division.

With a new look management team in Ray Johnston & Elliot Gibbons, the club has made a number of changes and now look forward to the upcoming season where they will be looking to push for promotion back into the Southern League.

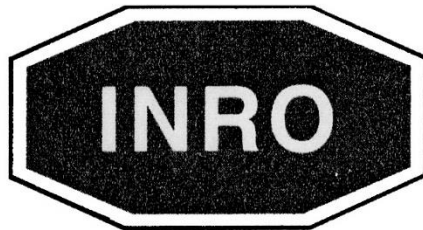

**As an FA Accredited Club, we expect all spectators to play your part and support the FA's Respect Code of Conduct at all times**

- Respect the referee's decisions even when you don't agree with them
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Appreciate good play whatever team it comes from
- Support positively. When players make a mistake offer them encouragement not criticism
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee and match officials
- Never engage in or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language
- Never engage in threatening or violent behaviour
- Stay behind the touchline and within the designated spectator's area

**You must fully understand and readily accept that failure to comply with any of the above may result in you being:**

- Issued with a verbal warning from a club or league official
- Obligated to leave the match venue by the club
- Required to meet with the club committee, league or Welfare Officer
- Obligated to undertake an FA education course
- Requested not to attend future games, be suspended or have your membership removed

**In addition:**

- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and/or suspension on the club
- Any physical assault on a Match Official will result in a lengthy or permanent exclusion from football and possibly a criminal prosecution
