WELLINGTON AFC Club History

Formed in 1892, we are proud to be a three-star FA Accredited Club and run more than 30 teams, providing football for hundreds of men, women, boys and girls throughout the season.

Initially, the club played in leagues based around Taunton and Tiverton. In the early 1960s, we gained promotion to the Somerset Senior League and succeeded in achieving Western League status in 1978 which has been retained ever since, making us one of the league's longest continuously serving members.

Since entering the Western League in the First Division, we have played at Premier Division level from 1981-82 to 1984-85 and 2008-09 to 2010-11. The team were then promoted as First Division champions at the end of the 2016-17 season and have since remained in the Premier Division.

In their first season back, the team finished a creditable 15th and also reached the semi-finals of the Somerset Premier Cup.

The side, who finished 15th in 2023-24, are now managed by Richard Cherry.

We have four other senior sides - the Reserves in the Devon and Exeter League's premier division, the A team in the Taunton Saturday League's premier division and the Ladies, who have two teams in the Somerset County Women's League.

We run 23 teams in our youth and minis with both boys and girls playing from the age of seven right through to 18 - along with coaching for even younger children.

We also have a thriving Disability section with two adult sides and two youth teams.

Off the pitch, Wellington AFC play a major role in the local community – we are home to a large number of skittles and darts teams and our social facilities are in use throughout the year for a wide range of events staged by local organisations, registered charities and individuals.

AFC ST AUSTELL

Wellington's run of defeats continued as they conceded the double to St Austell at the Playing Field last Saturday, (December 14th).

The result was all the more disappointing because the visitors – eight places below them in the table – played for more than half with match with ten men after a red card.

The Tangerines were playing their first league game in a month and manager Richard Cherry was able to welcome back skipper Kieran Bailey for his first start since suffering an ankle injury, while the subs included young striker Alex Parsons, signed from Street.

Both sides had their chances in the first half with home keeper Jake Viney pulling off an excellent double save and, at the other end, Mark Cornish was denied by an equally fine save from Andrew Collings.

But the game took a dramatic turn eight minutes before the break when a lunging tackle on Jordan Hayman by St Austell's Ollie Brokenshire saw him sent off with Hayman booked for his reaction.

That boosted Wellington's hopes of a breakthrough but they lost their way in the second half and were indebted to Viney for another flying save to push over a deflected shot after 53 minutes.

Jake Quick turned Sam Gleeson's cross just wide of the post shortly afterwards before St Austell broke the deadlock on the hour mark. A corner from the right was headed towards goal and big striker Adam Carter gave Viney no chance with a thumping header.

Wellington threw men forward in search of an equaliser but man-of-the-match Bailey saw one fierce drive deflected over and another, in the closing minutes, superbly turned over by Collings.

It was a fourth successive defeat for the Tangerines – now tenth in the table – and they’ll be looking to put that right this afternoon when Torpoint Athletic visit the Playing Field.

TODAY'S VISITORS TORPOINT ATHLETIC

Torpoint Athletic joined the South Western League in Season 1962/63 the club was fortunate to have many local players within the team.

They won the South Western League Championship on two occasions 1964/65 and 1966/67. The club won the Charity Cup on three occasions 1966, 1967 and 1968. Torpoint Athletic lost in the final of the South Western League Cup in 1965/66 and the Cornwall Senior Cup in 1967/68. The club competed in the FA Amateur Cup reaching the second round on several occasions

Altogether eleven enjoyable years were spent at Defiance Field. The ground had an end to end slope with good playing surface that encouraged good football. The support was good with crowds often of over a thousand watching matches, especially during the Amateur Cup runs. However, it was always a wish of the club to return to what many considered to be the traditional home of local football in Torpoint "The Mill". In 1970 the option to buy "The Mill" was offered to the club.

The committee led by Chairman Mr Reg. Devonshire and Secretary Keith Lillyman formed the "Two Hundred Club". This weekly and monthly draw helped the club raise the finance required. In 1971 Torpoint Athletic purchased "The Mill". The grand opening of the pitch took place on Wednesday August 11th 1971. Torpoint Athletic played a County Eleven losing the match by three goals to two.

During the nineties the club competed in the FA Vase competition. They played against sides such as Chippenham Town, Diss Town, Eastleigh, Exmouth and Tunbridge Wells. In the season 1995/96 the club had it's best run in the competition losing to Raunds Town two nil in the fifth round. Unfortunately, as the competition required clubs to have floodlights Torpoint were unable to enter the competition until 09/10 season.

The club remained in the South Western League until its final season in 06/07. Torpoint got promoted in last minute of the game when Darren Hicks scored to beat Penryn Athletic 3-2 in a very exciting game.

From season 2008/09 the Club played in the South West Peninsula Premier Division East and finished League Champions in 2021/22 which meant promotion to the Western League, Premier Division (Step 5), the highest level Torpoint Athletic have ever played at.

In their first season in the Western League they came a creditable 12th under the manager ship of Dean Cardew and his assistant Ryan Fice. In the FA Cup they reached the 1st Qualifying Round losing to Helston Athletic 2-1. In the FA Vase they reached the 1st Round Proper losing to Brimscombe & Thrupp on penalties and in the Les Phillips League Cup they reached the 3rd round after losing to Buckland Athletic, also in the Cornwall Senior Cup they lost to the Helston Athletic on penalties at The Mill in the 1st Round.

Last season they finished 10th in the League. In the FA Cup they lost to Buckland Athletic in the Extra Preliminary Round. They reached the First Round Proper of the FA Vase losing in penalties at home to Portland United of the Wessex League. They lost to Buckland Athletic in the Les Phillips Cup on penalties and reached the second round of the Cornwall Senior Cup Losing to Falmouth Town 2-0 at Bickland Park.

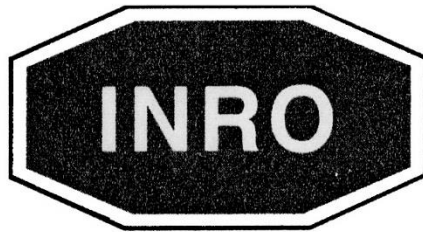

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR SPECTATORS



As an FA Accredited Club, we expect all spectators to play your part and support the FA's Respect Code of Conduct at all times

- Respect the referee's decisions even when you don't agree with them
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Appreciate good play whatever team it comes from
- Support positively. When players make a mistake offer them encouragement not criticism
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee and match officials
- Never engage in or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language
- Never engage in threatening or violent behaviour
- Stay behind the touchline and within the designated spectator's area

You must fully understand and readily accept that failure to comply with any of the above may result in you being:

- Issued with a verbal warning from a club or league official
- Obligated to leave the match venue by the club
- Required to meet with the club committee, league or Welfare Officer
- Obligated to undertake an FA education course
- Requested not to attend future games, be suspended or have your membership removed

In addition:

- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and/or suspension on the club
- Any physical assault on a Match Official will result in a lengthy or permanent exclusion from football and possibly a criminal prosecution
