WELLINGTON AFC Club History

Formed in 1892, we are proud to be a three-star FA Accredited Club and run more than 30 teams, providing football for hundreds of men, women, boys and girls throughout the season.

Initially, the club played in leagues based around Taunton and Tiverton. In the early 1960s, we gained promotion to the Somerset Senior League and succeeded in achieving Western League status in 1978 which has been retained ever since, making us one of the league's longest continuously serving members.

Since entering the Western League in the First Division, we have played at Premier Division level from 1981-82 to 1984-85 and 2008-09 to 2010-11. The team were then promoted as First Division champions at the end of the 2016-17 season and have since remained in the Premier Division.

In their first season back, the team finished a creditable 15th and also reached the semi-finals of the Somerset Premier Cup.

The side, who finished 15th in 2023-24, are now managed by Richard Cherry.

We have four other senior sides - the Reserves in the Devon and Exeter League's premier division, the A team in the Taunton Saturday League's premier division and the Ladies, who have two teams in the Somerset County Women's League.

We run 23 teams in our youth and minis with both boys and girls playing from the age of seven right through to 18 - along with coaching for even younger children.

We also have a thriving Disability section with two adult sides and two youth teams.

Off the pitch, Wellington AFC play a major role in the local community – we are home to a large number of skittles and darts teams and our social facilities are in use throughout the year for a wide range of events staged by local organisations, registered charities and individuals.

We are also installing new floodlights in August – with four corner mounted LED pylons being installed. These will be cheaper to run than the existing eight pylons, four of which currently have to be taken down and then put back up again to allow Wellington Cricket Club to play their fixtures during the summer. We are also planning to install a new pitch surround to further improve the look of the ground and provide enhanced opportunities for local companies wishing to advertise.

Thanks are given all those who came along. It was another memorable day – topped off by wins for both the first team and reserves.

MATCH REPORT

WELLINGTON 3 1 WELTON ROVERS

Wellington ensured another season of premier division football as they got back to winning ways at the Playing Field on Saturday (March 29th). Victory over bottom club Welton Rovers means they cannot be caught by second-from-bottom Ilfracombe Town with five games left to play.

Kick-off had to be delayed by 15 minutes after a car containing several Welton players broke down and, when it did get under way, the visitors – with only one win to their name all season – had the bare 11 players with no subs.

It was, therefore, little surprise that Wellington dominated proceedings although the plucky Welton outfit gave them a shock by pulling a goal back in the second half.

Perhaps the only surprise was that the margin of victory was not bigger as the Tangerines peppered the visitors' goal with shots and also missed a penalty.

In front of more than 30 past players, who were holding their annual reunion, Wellington went on the attack straight from the kick-off. They took the lead after 17 minutes when a corner by skipper Sam Towler was headed home at the near post by Nathan Byrne.

It was one-way traffic for the rest of the first half although the hosts were unable to add to their tally. They had a chance to make it 2-0 six minutes after the break when Byrne was sent tumbling in the box but Towler missed from the spot for the second game running – this time firing against the bar.

Wellington were not to be denied and doubled their tally just after the hour mark thanks to the persistence of striker Phil Mendonca who wriggled into space before poking a low shot just inside the far post.

It looked a question of just how many goals the hosts would score but Welton shocked them by making it 2-1 as Kamal Yassin intercepted a back pass and hit the post before thumping home the rebound.

However, any hopes of a dramatic turnaround were foiled as Wellington added a third goal with eight minutes remaining. Substitute Charlie Wood, a new signing from Buckland Athletic, found young defender Jacob Shore in the box and he brought the ball under control before shooting home his first goal for the club.

The Tangerines' run of home games continues on this evening when Street are the visitors and, on Saturday when Saltash United visit the Playing Field. (kick-off 3.00pm).

The game was preceded by a minute's applause to remember supporter and former player George Govier, whose funeral had taken place the previous day.

TONIGHT'S VISITORS STREET

Street FC were given the nickname 'The Cobblers' due to the large shoemaking industry in the village and surrounding area.

The Club won the Somerset Senior League 5 times and the Somerset FA Senior Cup 3 times before making its first foray into the Western League a few seasons before the onset of World War One. The Club also had its best FA Cup runs reaching the First Round Proper twice, once either side of World War Two; in 1938 away to Ipswich Town and 1947 at Cheltenham Town -after beating Yeovil Town 2-1 in front of a record 5,000 crowd at The Victoria Field in the previous round.

The closest the Club came to winning the Western League Championship during the 20th century was in season 1952-53 when they were pipped to the title by Barnstaple Town, who had a 0.01 better goal average after the sides had finished level on 44 points each. Season 1996-97 saw the Club win the Somerset Senior League for a record eighth time, thus gaining promotion back to the Western League after a 37- year absence.

Ten years later, after gaining promotion to the Premier Division in season 2005-06, the Club had its best run in The FA Vase when reaching the Fifth Round Proper before losing at Wimborne Town. After finishing as Premier Division Runners-up the previous season, the 2017-18 campaign was the Club's 50th in the Western League, and was a momentous one too!

Early results were inconsistent: but starting on 12th September, manager Richard Fey's charges completed a sensational run of

26 consecutive league victories that eventually saw the team win the title by 15 points (falling just one point short of the century) after winning 32 of their 38 games and scoring 100 goals, thus earning a place in the Southern Football League for the first time in the Club's 138-year history.


However, 2018-19 was to be the only season at the higher level for the Club as it soon became clear that Southern League football was a 'step too far': and despite a respectable seventh-place finish, the decision was taken to protect the long-term future of the Club and return to the Toolstation Western League.

In 2023/24 the Victoria Sports first joined the club to make up the reserves team squad. They did well finishing in 5th, and this season James Carey has been appointed Manager to try and get the team back to Division 1 of the county league after achieving this feat with local county league side Ashcott.

2024/25 is set to be a new exciting chapter for club with a new committee team, a rebrand plus Ben Watson and Scott Laird appointed as new managers.

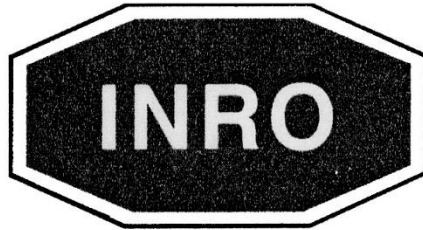

- Appreciate good play whatever team it comes from
- Support positively. When players make a mistake offer them encouragement not criticism
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee and match officials
- Never engage in or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language
- Never engage in threatening or violent behaviour
- Stay behind the touchline and within the designated spectator's area

You must fully understand and readily accept that failure to comply with any of the above may result in you being:

- Issued with a verbal warning from a club or league official
- Obligated to leave the match venue by the club
- Required to meet with the club committee, league or Welfare Officer
- Obligated to undertake an FA education course
- Requested not to attend future games, be suspended or have your membership removed

In addition:

- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and/or suspension on the club
- Any physical assault on a Match Official will result in a lengthy or permanent exclusion from football and possibly a criminal prosecution
