## WELLINGTON AFC Club History

Formed in 1892, we are proud to be a three-star FA Accredited Club and run more than 30 teams, providing football for hundreds of men, women, boys and girls throughout the season.

Initially, the club played in leagues based around Taunton and Tiverton. In the early 1960s, we gained promotion to the Somerset Senior League and succeeded in achieving Western League status in 1978 which has been retained ever since, making us one of the league's longest continuously serving members.

Since entering the Western League in the First Division, we played at Premier Division level from 1981-82 to 1984-85 and 2008-09 to 2010-11. The team were then promoted as First Division champions at the end of the 2016-17 season and have since remained in the Premier Division. In their first season back, the team finished a creditable 15th and also reached the semi-finals of the Somerset Premier Cup. The side finished 13<sup>th</sup> in 2024-25 with their highest points total for a number of years.

We have three other senior sides - the Reserves in the Devon and Exeter League's premier division, the A team in the Taunton Saturday League's premier division and the Wildcats Ladies, in the Somerset County Women's League first division.

We run well over 20 teams in our youth and minis section with both boys and girls playing from the age of seven right through to 18 - along with coaching for even younger children.

We also have a thriving Abilities Counts section which runs teams for both adults and youth players.

Off the pitch, Wellington AFC play a major role in the local community – we are home to a large number of skittles and darts teams and our facilities are in use throughout the year for a wide range of social events staged by local groups, registered charities and individuals.

We also host training courses, seminars and roadshows for local businesses and organisations.

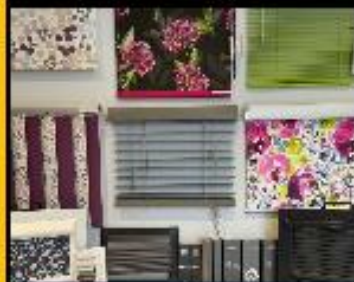

## MATCH REPORT

### Jewson Western League – Premier Division

**WELLINGTON**                      **0**                      **1**                      **Paulton Rovers**

A contentious second-half penalty consigned Wellington to a narrow defeat by third-placed Paulton Rovers at the Carly Press Ground last Saturday.

Both sides entered the game with momentum with Paulton pushing towards the top of the table, while Wellington were looking to build on their midweek victory at Street. But it was a cagey opening 45 minutes, with few clear chances for either side.

Wellington had the first real opportunity in the ninth minute, with an effort going wide despite appeals for offside from the visitors. Paulton responded with a spell of pressure around the half-hour mark, earning several corners but failing to convert.

The second half saw more urgency, particularly from the visitors. Paulton came out of the blocks with intent, forcing two strong saves from Wellington keeper Jack McAndrews on 50 minutes to keep things level. Moments later, Wellington nearly caught Paulton out with a dangerous back pass which skidded just wide of the post.

As the game opened up, both defences were tested and Tom Stone produced a superb last-ditch tackle in the 59th minute to deny Paulton.

The breakthrough finally came in the 67th minute – but not without controversy. A high boot from Jack Alcock was judged to have made contact with the Paulton striker in the box, and the referee pointed to the spot. Joel Smedley made no mistake from 12 yards, tucking the penalty away to give the visitors the lead.

Wellington pushed for an equaliser but were nearly punished again late on, with Paulton hitting both the crossbar and the post in quick succession around the 85th minute.

Despite a spirited performance from the home side, the score stayed at 1-0 with Paulton taking all three points. Wellington will feel hard done by the

penalty decision, but they showed enough resilience and quality to take positives into the game away at Sidmouth Town on Tuesday night

**SIDMOUTH 3 0 WELLINGTON**

Wellington suffered their second defeat in four days as they were beaten away to newly-promoted Sidmouth Town on Tuesday evening.

The match began in bizarre fashion — or rather, it didn't. Just 33 seconds after kick-off, all the floodlights went out, plunging Manstone Lane into darkness and prompting a temporary halt in play. Thankfully, after a brief delay, the game resumed.

Once the lights were back on, it was the hosts who shone brightest. Sidmouth came close in just the second minute, rattling the post with a header from an early corner — a warning sign for Wellington. The visitors responded with a free-kick in the seventh minute, but it was comfortably blocked by the wall.

The breakthrough came in the 11th minute. Sidmouth's Zack Williams was allowed too much space on the edge of the area and made Wellington pay, curling a precise effort into the far corner to give the hosts a deserved lead.

Wellington tried to respond with a speculative effort from Jacob Shore in the 21st minute, but it sailed harmlessly over the bar. Sidmouth, meanwhile, continued to threaten and might have doubled their advantage in the 26th minute, only to fire over after a swift break.

As the half wore on, Wellington found some joy down the flanks, with Oscar Albano and Nathan Byrne combining well in the 40th minute, but the final ball was lacking, and Sidmouth quickly turned defence into attack — although without further reward before the break.

The second half followed a similar pattern and, just seven minutes in, Sidmouth extended their lead as a corner was headed home at the back post by Cholwe Hachipuka.

Wellington struggled to mount a serious response, and the game was effectively over in the 72nd minute when another unmarked header from a corner, this time by Craig Veal, made it 3–0.

It was a deserved win for Sidmouth to continue their impressive start following promotion from the South West Peninsula League.

For the Tangerines, it was a frustrating evening and they will look to regroup quickly for today's home clash against another of last season's promoted sides, Newquay.

## TODAY'S VISITORS NEWQUAY

Newquay Association Football Club is a football club based in Newquay, Cornwall, England. Nicknamed “The Peppermints”, due to their Red/White striped shirts, they have recently been promoted for the 2025-26 Season to the Jewson Western League Premier Division West and play at Mount Wise Stadium.

The club was established in 1890 as Newquay Football Club, but did not play any competitive games until entering the Cornwall Senior Cup in 1896–97. They were renamed Newquay One and All in 1903 and went on to win the Cornwall Charity Shield in 1906–07. After folding in 1912, the club was re-established as Newquay Rovers in 1920. The new club joined the Plymouth & District League, but left in 1927 due to the cost of travelling. In 1931 they were founder members of the Cornwall Senior League, going on to win the league and the Cornwall Senior Cup in 1934–35. However, the club disbanded in 1937.

The current incarnation of the club was formed in 1946, re-joining the Cornwall Senior League. In 1951 they were founder members of the South Western League. They won the Cornwall Senior Cup in 1952–53, 1954–55 and 1956–57, before finishing as runners-up in the South Western League in 1957–58. They were league champions the following season and retained the title in 1959–60. The club won the league again in 1977–78, 1979–80, 1981–82 and 1983–84, before finishing as runners-up in 1984–85. They were South Western League champions for a seventh time in 1987–88 and finished as runners-up in 1991–92, as well as winning the Cornwall Senior Cup. They finished second in the league again in 1993–94.


In 2007 the South Western League merged with the Devon County League to form the South West Peninsula League, with Newquay

placed in Division One West. They were runners-up in the division in 2008–09 and then champions in 2011–12, earning promotion to the Premier Division. Following league reorganisation at the end of the 2018–19 season, the club were placed in the Premier Division West. In 2025 under the Management of Shaun Middleton assisted by Ross Maynard, Newquay won the South West Peninsula League West Division which gained them promotion to the Jewson Western League Premier Division for the 2025-26 season.

The club have played at Mount Wise on Clevedon Road since 1922, when Newquay Urban District Council leased the site to the club. Floodlights were erected in the 1980s and inaugurated with a friendly match against West Bromwich Albion. The club's record attendance of 3,500 was set for a friendly match against Manchester City on 14th July 1998, with the visitors winning 6–0. The Floodlights were replaced due to storm damage prior to the 2021 – 2022 Season.

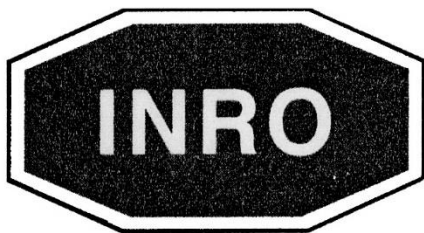
