WELLINGTON AFC Club History

Formed in 1892, we are proud to be a three-star FA Accredited Club and run more than 30 teams, providing football for hundreds of men, women, boys and girls throughout the season.

Initially, the club played in leagues based around Taunton and Tiverton. In the early 1960s, we gained promotion to the Somerset Senior League and succeeded in achieving Western League status in 1978 which has been retained ever since, making us one of the league's longest continuously serving members.

Since entering the Western League in the First Division, we played at Premier Division level from 1981-82 to 1984-85 and 2008-09 to 2010-11. The team were then promoted as First Division champions at the end of the 2016-17 season and have since remained in the Premier Division. In their first season back, the team finished a creditable 15th and also reached the semi-finals of the Somerset Premier Cup. The side finished 13th in 2024-25 with their highest points total for a number of years.

We have three other senior sides - the Reserves in the Devon and Exeter League's premier division, the A team in the Taunton Saturday League's premier division and the Wildcats Ladies, in the Somerset County Women's League first division.

We run well over 20 teams in our youth and minis section with both boys and girls playing from the age of seven right through to 18 - along with coaching for even younger children.

We also have a thriving Abilities Counts section which runs teams for both adults and youth players.

Off the pitch, Wellington AFC play a major role in the local community – we are home to a large number of skittles and darts teams and our facilities are in use throughout the year for a wide range of social events staged by local groups, registered charities and individuals.

We also host training courses, seminars and roadshows for local businesses and organisations.

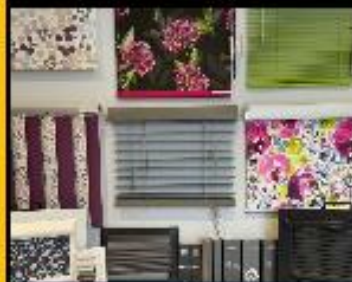

MATCH REPORTS

Jewson Western League – Premier Division WELLINGTON 3 3 NEWQUAY

Wellington produced a spirited display to claim their first home point of the season in a thrilling draw against in-form Newquay last Saturday (October 4th).

After back-to-back defeats, the Tangerines led three times in an entertaining contest which ebbed and flowed from start to finish. The hosts made the perfect start when, inside the first minute, Josh Lukins released Oscar Albano, who unleashed a stunning 25-yard strike into the top corner to spark early celebrations at the Carly Press Ground.

But Newquay – who beat leaders Clevedon Town the previous week – hit back almost immediately, Jack Bray-Evans bundling home a low cross from the left to equalise inside three minutes.

Home keeper Jack McAndrews then kept the scores level with a sharp save moments later, before Wellington went close themselves through Josh Baker's header.

The home side regained the lead on 24 minutes as player of the match Miles Quick's teasing free-kick caused confusion in the Newquay box, the ball came off a defender into the top corner with Tom Stone claiming the final touch.

The visitors continued to threaten and were denied by the underside of the bar before Rhys Simmonds turned in a low cross to equalise again on 34 minutes.

Despite the strong wind, a pulsating first half ended 2–2, with both sides showing plenty of attacking intent.

After the restart, McAndrews produced another fine stop to keep Newquay at bay before Wellington went ahead for a third time on 64 minutes.

Nathan Byrne's cross was only half-cleared and fell perfectly for Alfie Slough, who drilled home his first goal for the club make it 3–2.

But once again Newquay responded almost instantly, Simmonds slotting home his second of the afternoon to restore parity just a minute later.

The closing stages saw Wellington push hard for a winner. Glen Wright and Miles Quick both went close, while Josh Baker's header was cleared off the line. In the 87th minute, Albano thought he had struck again as he hit the bar and then smashed home the rebound, but the effort was ruled out for an infringement spotted by the referee. At the other end, McAndrews pulled off a superb double save late on to deny Newquay who also missed a good chance before the final whistle.

CLEVEDON TOWN 3 1 WELLINGTON

A spirited display against league leaders Clevedon Town ended in frustration as two late goals condemned the Tangerines to defeat at the Hand Stadium on Wednesday evening.

The visitors made a bright start and took the game to the hosts from the outset. Their early enterprise was rewarded in the 18th minute when James De Selincourt drove forward purposefully and sent in a low cross which Josh Baker turned home at the far post to give Wellington a deserved lead.

There was a lengthy stoppage immediately after the goal as Clevedon's goalkeeper Jakob Glover was injured after colliding with Baker and had to be replaced — with striker Sam Beresford taking over between the posts.

Wellington looked to make the most of the situation, with Douglas Camilo and Baker both going close before the break while, at the other end, keeper

Jack McAndrews produced a superb save to preserve the slender advantage at half-time.

Clevedon switched formation at the restart, moving to three at the back, and began to find their rhythm. But Baker twice tested the stand-in keeper early in the second half, while Miles Quick almost doubled Wellington's lead in spectacular fashion with a free-kick from his own half which was tipped over the bar by Beresford.

Clevedon began to get on top and the pressure eventually told in the 67th minute when a long throw into the Wellington box was only partially cleared and Seb Scott drilled home the equaliser.

McAndrews produced a string of fine saves to keep his side in contention while Wellington also went close as Nathan Byrne's fierce drive was tipped away by Beresford who adapted well to his unaccustomed role.

The slick-passing hosts continued to push forward and their persistence paid off late on. In the 86th minute, a cross from the left found Charlie Saunders, who bundled the ball over the line to put them ahead.

Deep into stoppage time, Scott struck again with a curling effort from the right to seal the points for Clevedon and give the scoreline a harsh look for the visitors.

Despite the defeat, Wellington could take heart from a determined performance which saw them match the leaders for long spells. They'll look to bounce back this afternoon against Torpoint Athletic, the only side yet to be beaten in the premier division.

TODAY'S VISITORS TORPOINT ATHLETIC

Torpoint Athletic joined the South Western League in Season 1962/63 the club was fortunate to have many local players within the team.

They won the South Western League Championship on two occasions 1964/65 and 1966/67. The club won the Charity Cup on three occasions 1966, 1967 and 1968. Torpoint Athletic lost in the final of the South Western League Cup in 1965/66 and the Cornwall Senior Cup in 1967/68. The club competed in the FA Amateur Cup reaching the second round on several occasions

Altogether eleven enjoyable years were spent at Defiance Field. The ground had an end to end slope with good playing surface that encouraged good football. The support was good with crowds often of over a thousand watching matches, especially during the Amateur Cup runs. However, it was always a wish of the club to return to what many considered to be the traditional home of local football in Torpoint "The Mill". In 1970 the option to buy "The Mill" was offered to the club.

The committee led by Chairman Mr Reg. Devonshire and Secretary Keith Lillyman formed the "Two Hundred Club". This weekly and monthly draw helped the club raise the finance required. In 1971 Torpoint Athletic purchased "The Mill". The grand opening of the pitch took place on Wednesday August 11th 1971. Torpoint Athletic played a County Eleven losing the match by three goals to two.

During the nineties the club competed in the FA Vase competition. They played against sides such as Chippenham Town, Diss Town, Eastleigh, Exmouth and Tunbridge Wells. In the season 1995/96 the club had its best run in the competition losing to Raunds Town two nil in the fifth round. Unfortunately, as the competition required clubs to have floodlights Torpoint were unable to enter the competition until 09/10 season.

The club remained in the South Western League until its final season in 06/07. Torpoint got promoted in last minute of the game when Darren Hicks scored to beat Penryn Athletic 3-2 in a very exciting game.


From season 2008/09 the Club played in the South West Peninsula Premier Division East and finished League Champions in 2021/22 which meant promotion to the Western League, Premier Division (Step 5), the highest level Torpoint Athletic have ever played at.

In their first season in the Western League, they came a creditable 12th under the manager ship of Dean Cardew and his assistant Ryan Fice. In the FA Cup they reached the 1st Qualifying Round losing to Helston Athletic 2-1. In the FA Vase they reached the 1st Round Proper losing to Brimscombe & Thrupp on penalties and in the Les Phillips League Cup they reached the 3rd round after losing to Buckland Athletic, also in the Cornwall Senior Cup they lost to the Helston Athletic on penalties at The Mill in the 1st Round.

In the 2023/2024 season they finished 10th in the League. In the FA Cup they lost to Buckland Athletic in the Extra Preliminary Round. They reached the First Round Proper of the FA Vase losing in penalties at home to Portland United of the Wessex League. They lost to Buckland Athletic in the Les Phillips Cup on penalties and reached the second round of the Cornwall Senior Cup Losing to Falmouth Town 2-0 at Bickland Park

Last season they finished in 15th place under the manager-ship of Ryan Rice with Dean Cardew re-joining the team just before Christmas, but achieved the best point tally since joining the Western league back in 2022. In the FA Cup, they exited the competition at the Extra Preliminary stage, losing 5-0 away to Southern League Division One South side Falmouth Town at Bickland Park. In the FA Vase they reached the 1st Round Proper losing 1-0 at home to Hellenic Premier side Thornbury Town, beating Honiton Town of the South West Peninsula League East Division, 2-0 away at Mountbatten Park in the 2nd Qualifying Round.

In the Les Phillips Cup, having been beaten on penalties at St Austell. In the first round. Finally in the Cornwall Senior Cup, they reached the 2nd Round after beating Bodmin Town in the 1st Round, 6-0 at Priory Park, but lost 6-2 away to St Austell in the 2nd Round at Poltair Park.

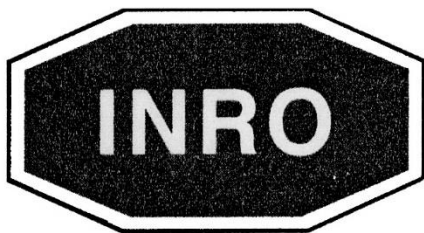
