WELLINGTON AFC Club History

Formed in 1892, we are proud to be a three-star FA Accredited Club and run more than 30 teams, providing football for hundreds of men, women, boys and girls throughout the season.

Initially, the club played in leagues based around Taunton and Tiverton. In the early 1960s, we gained promotion to the Somerset Senior League and succeeded in achieving Western League status in 1978 which has been retained ever since, making us one of the league's longest continuously serving members.

Since entering the Western League in the First Division, we played at Premier Division level from 1981-82 to 1984-85 and 2008-09 to 2010-11. The team were then promoted as First Division champions at the end of the 2016-17 season and have since remained in the Premier Division. In their first season back, the team finished a creditable 15th and also reached the semi-finals of the Somerset Premier Cup. The side finished 13th in 2024-25 with their highest points total for a number of years.

We have three other senior sides - the Reserves in the Devon and Exeter League's premier division, the A team in the Taunton Saturday League's premier division and the Wildcats Ladies, in the Somerset County Women's League first division.

We run well over 20 teams in our youth and minis section with both boys and girls playing from the age of seven right through to 18 - along with coaching for even younger children.

We also have a thriving Abilities Counts section which runs teams for both adults and youth players.

Off the pitch, Wellington AFC play a major role in the local community – we are home to a large number of skittles and darts teams and our facilities are in use throughout the year for a wide range of social events staged by local groups, registered charities and individuals.

We also host training courses, seminars and roadshows for local businesses and organisations.

MATCH REPORT
WELLINGTON 1 1 SALTASH UNITED

An equaliser deep into stoppage time denied Wellington victory at the Carly Press Ground on Saturday, March 28th.

Richard Cherry's side were set to bounce back from their midweek defeat by Brislington by taking all three points, only to be denied right at the death.

Chances were few and far between in a game which was affected by a strong wind blowing from one end of the pitch to the other.

After a cagey opening, it was Saltash who began to look the more threatening side as the first half wore on, making use of the wind at their backs without creating any clear-cut openings.

The visitors registered the first real effort on 39 minutes when Jack Jeffers met a delivery with a firm header, but Wellington goalkeeper Andy Collings was equal to it, producing a solid save to keep the scores level.

Just a minute later, Wellington broke the deadlock in spectacular fashion. Josh Baker provided the assist, feeding Alfie Slough who unleashed a superb 25-yard volley which flew into the top corner to give the hosts a 1-0 lead going into the break.

Wellington looked to build on their advantage in the second half, with Baker again involved as his well-struck effort on 71 minutes forced Saltash keeper Tyler Coombes into a fine save, tipping the ball over the bar.

As the game moved into its closing stages, the visitors increased the pressure and a dangerous cross in the 90th minute saw player of the match Miles Quick diving to head the ball back into the hands of his keeper Andy Collings while under pressure.

Saltash pushed for an equaliser and had an appeal for a penalty turned down before the ball was driven just wide.

Their efforts were rewarded in the 96th minute when a free kick came out to Tyler Yendle who curled a composed finish in off the inside of the post to snatch a dramatic late leveller and ensure the points were shared.



Defender Miles Quick was player of the match and he received the award from our former striker Bob Cummins who was among those attending the past players' reunion.

MATCH REPORT
BARNSTAPLE TOWN 4 1 WELLINGTON

Wellington suffered a Good Friday defeat at the hands of promotion chasing Barnstaple Town.

The North Devon club, who have already guaranteed a spot in the end-of-season play-offs, are still in the hunt for the title and an automatic step up into the Southern League. They were quick out of the blocks from the kick-off and dominated the early stages of a game played in a blustery wind.

Keeper Andy Collings has called upon to produce a smart block with his chest to deny the hosts inside the opening minute.

However, the pressure soon told. On seven minutes, Wellington failed to clear their lines and Shea Bennington-Mannings capitalised, turning sharply to fire home from 12 yards.

Barnstaple continued to press, firing over from close range soon after, but Wellington gradually steadied themselves. Midway through the half they came close to an equaliser when Jordan Hayman's goal-bound header was cleared off the line.

However, the game's key moment arrived on the half-hour mark with a controversial penalty decision. A cross into the box resulted in a handball call from the referee's assistant, much to Wellington's frustration, and Tommy Rogers made no mistake from the spot to double the lead.

The visitors responded positively, with Mark Cornish volleying over and Oscar Albano curling a teasing cross against the bar in quick succession, but they went into the break two goals down.

The second half followed a similar pattern, with Barnstaple largely in control.

Josh Lukins produced an excellent goal-line clearance to prevent a third, while Wellington's task became harder when skipper Glen Wright was forced off through injury before the hour mark.


Despite being under sustained pressure, the Tangerines found a lifeline on 71 minutes. Substitute Nathan Byrne, back from injury, showed good awareness to find space, swivel and deliver a low cross which Charlie Shearer converted to make it 2-1.

Unfortunately, the comeback hopes were short-lived as Barnstaple restored their cushion just four minutes later when Gabriel Rogers' cross was flicked home by Tre Davey.

Any remaining doubt was removed five minutes from time when Collings made an initial save, only for Neil Slateford to react quickest and convert the rebound to seal a comfortable 4-1 victory for the hosts.

SIDMOUTH TOWN

Sidmouth Town Association Football Club is a football club based in Sidmouth, Devon, England. They are currently members of the Western League Premier Division and play at Manstone Lane.

History

Sidmouth Town were members of the Exeter and District League for many decades, finishing as runners-up in the Premier Division in 1959–60, and winning it in 1967–68.^[1] They won the renamed Devon and Exeter League Premier Division in 2010–11, having finished as runners-up the previous season.^[2] They were subsequently promoted to the South West Peninsula League Division One East.^[3] At the end of 2018–19 the league was restructured, and Sidmouth successfully applied for promotion to the Premier Division East, at Step 6 of the National League System.

The club competed in the FA Vase for the first time in 2018–19.^[4] They won their first-qualifying-round match 3–2 against Keynsham Town and followed that up with a second win, 4–1 against Godolphin Atlantic. Following these two matches, both against sides one level higher in the pyramid, they lost 5–0 in the first round proper to Cadbury Heath, from two levels above them.

The 2024–25 season saw Sidmouth Town promoted to step five for the first time in the club's history, crowned champions of the South West Peninsula Premier Division East.

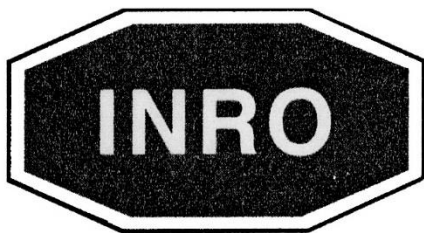
